



GLOBAL BAROMETER OF VIEWS ON NUCLEAR ENERGY After Japan Earthquake

Volume 1: TABULAR PRESENTATION OF ALL 8 QUESTIONS COUNTRY-WISE

Findings based on responses from more than over 34,000 scientifically selected cross-section of Men and Women from all socio-economic classes from across the globe. The interviews were conducted by leading pollsters in 47 countries spanning all parts of Asia, Africa, Latin America and Australasia.

The error margin for national samples is generally $\pm 3-5\%$ at 95% confidence level. Field Work was carried out in March 21-April 10, 2011. Details on Field Work modes are provided in Methods Report.
