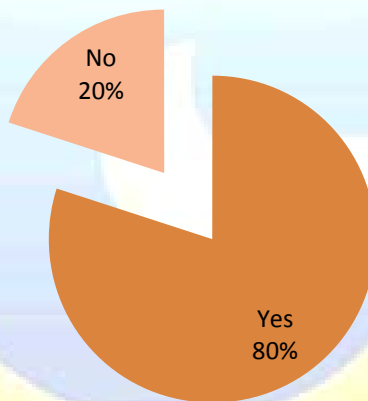
**Role of narcotics in crime: 4 in 5 Pakistanis say that smuggling and use of narcotics gives rise to other crimes. (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)**

Islamabad, March 21, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 4 in 5 Pakistanis say that smuggling and use of narcotics give rise to other crimes.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, ““In your opinion, does smuggling and use of narcotics gives rise to other crimes or not?” In response to this question, 80% said yes, smuggling and use of narcotics give rise to other crimes, while 20% said no.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1803 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during January 16 – January 23, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  per cent at 95% confidence level.
