Eid: Azha, Fitr, Eid Milad un Nabi

7 in 10 Pakistanis say they celebrated the recent Eid in the city where they live. (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)

Islamabad, August 7, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 7 out of 10 Pakistanis say they celebrated the recent Eid in the city where they live, whereas 3 out of 10 travelled to another place for Eid.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Where did you celebrate Eid this time?" Responding to this, 76% said they celebrated Eid in the city where they lived, 12% said in another city and 12% said in their ancestral village.


Trend Analysis:

In response to this question in January 2003, 79% said they celebrated Eid in the city where they lived, 13% said in another city and 8% said in their ancestral village.

In December 2009, 65% said they celebrated Eid in the city where they lived, 6% said in another city and 21% said in their ancestral village.

According to public opinion, the preference among Pakistanis to celebrate Eid in the city where they lived and in another city has somewhat declined by 3% and 1%, respectively, over a period of 14 years, however there has been a 4% increase in the proportion of Pakistanis who now celebrate Eid in their ancestral village.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1790 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 03 - July 10, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2-3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
