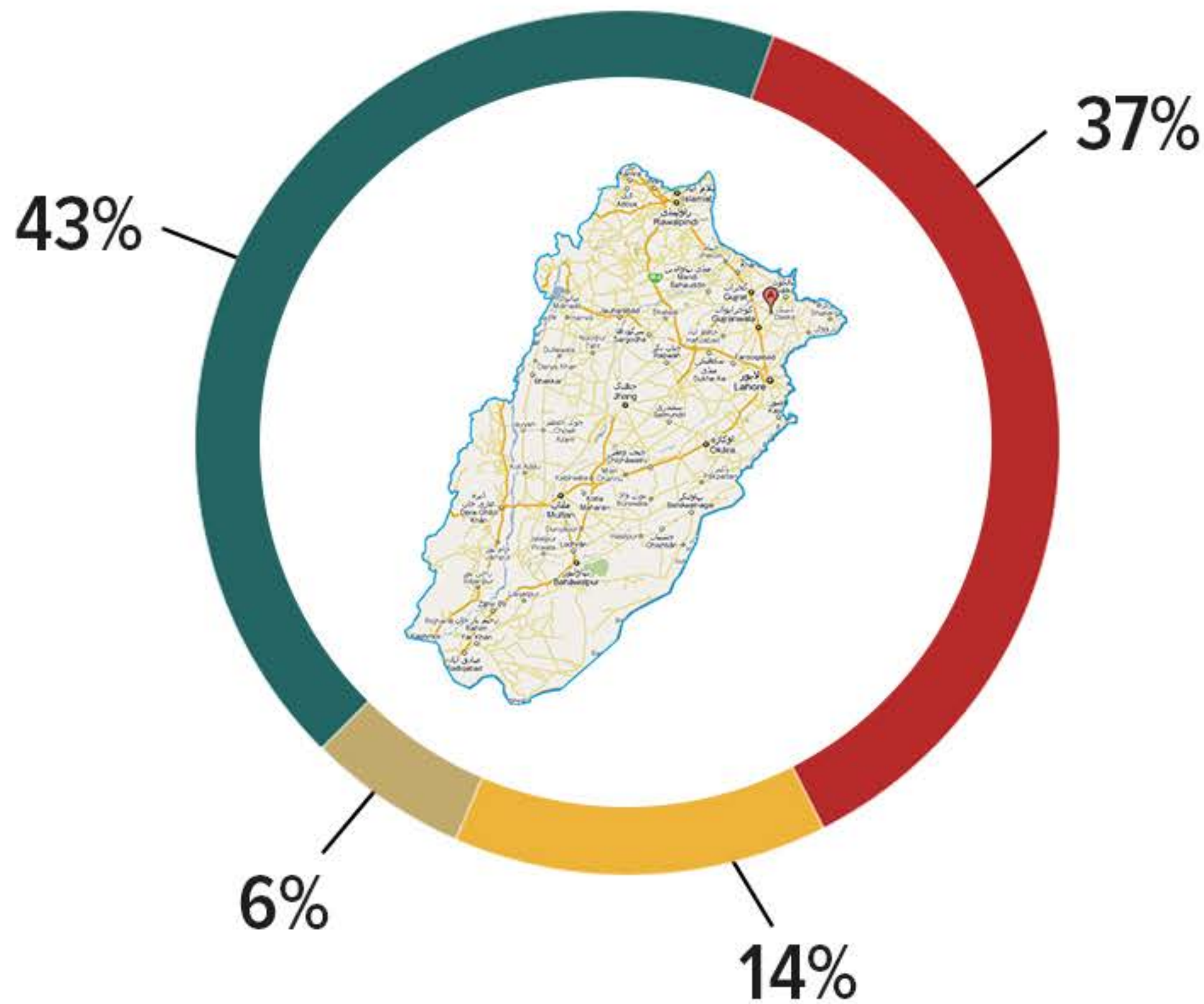

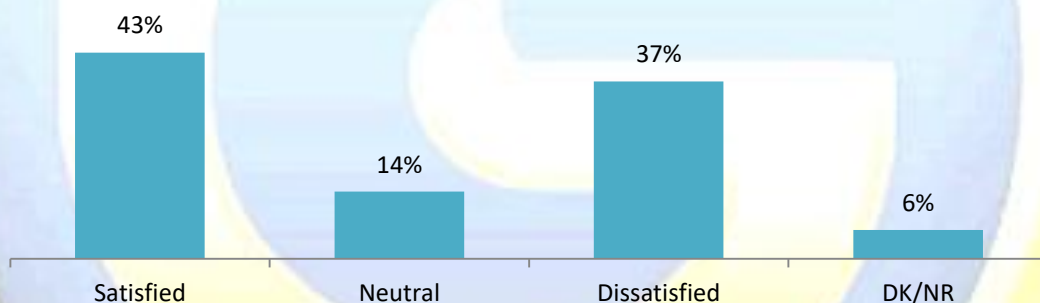
**Opinions on the Punjab Government: 43% Pakistanis and 48% people in Punjab report that they are satisfied with the performance of the Punjab government since PTI won the 2018 elections. (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)**

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 43% Pakistanis and 48% people in Punjab report that they are satisfied with the performance of the federal government since PTI won the 2018 elections.

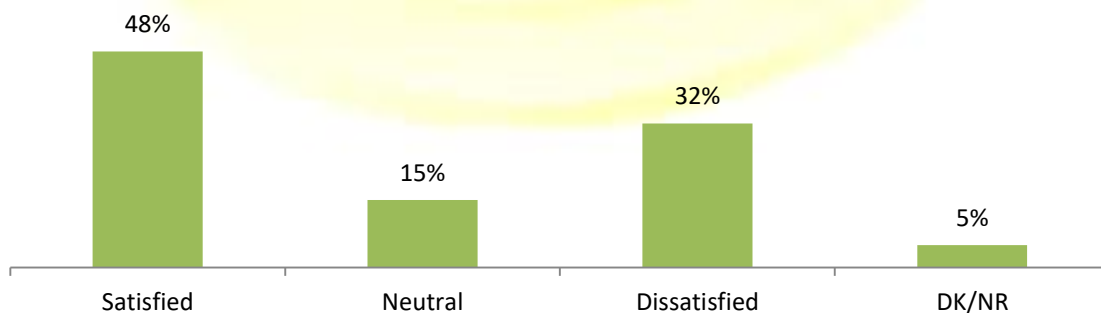
A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “To what extent are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the overall performance of the Punjab government since PTI won the elections in 2018?” In response to this question, 43% expressed satisfaction with regard to its performance, 14% neutrality, 37% dissatisfaction, while 6% did not know or did not wish to respond.

**Opinions in Punjab:** Respondents from Punjab appear to have a more favourable view of their government than those from across the country. In response to the question, 48% of respondents from Punjab reported their satisfaction with the Punjab government, 15% their neutrality, 32% their dissatisfaction, while 5% did not know or did not wish to respond.

**Approval rating in the context of the 2018 election:** Considering that in the 2018 general elections, PTI received around 34% of votes in Punjab, the satisfaction rating of 48% shows that despite criticism from opposition political parties, at least a portion of voters of opposition parties themselves rate PTI's Punjab government positively in terms of approval ratings.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,141 men and women in rural as well as urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during 22 December – 29 December, 2018. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  percent at the 95% confidence level.
