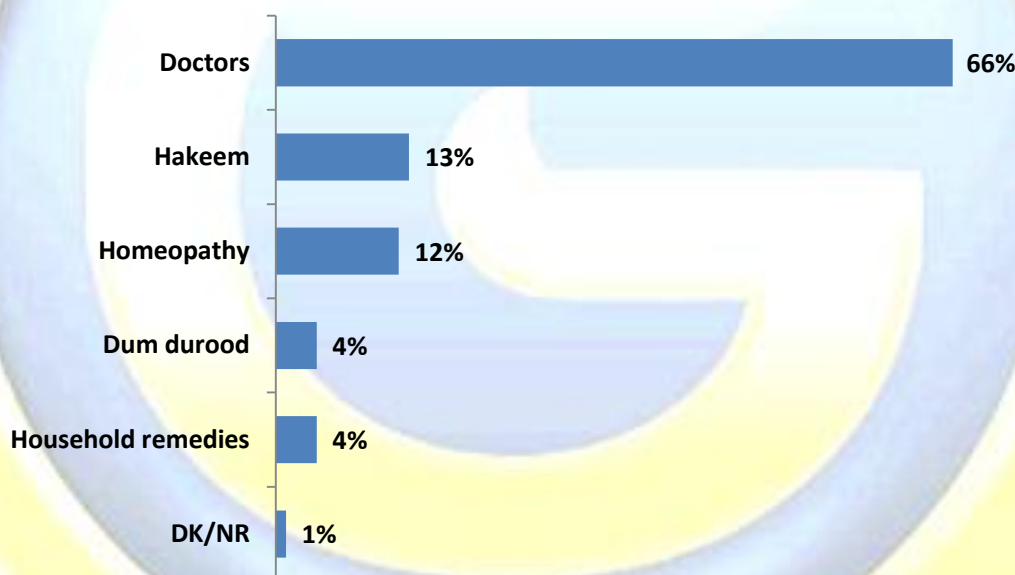

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, at 66%, majority of Pakistanis prefer to visit a doctor if they happen to be sick, while 13% say they go to a hakeem.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Which method of treatment do you prefer the most?” In response to this question, 66% said visiting a doctor, 13% said hakeem, 12% said homeopathy, 4% said *dum durood*, 4% said household remedies, while 1% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1142 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during 24 January – 28 January, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
