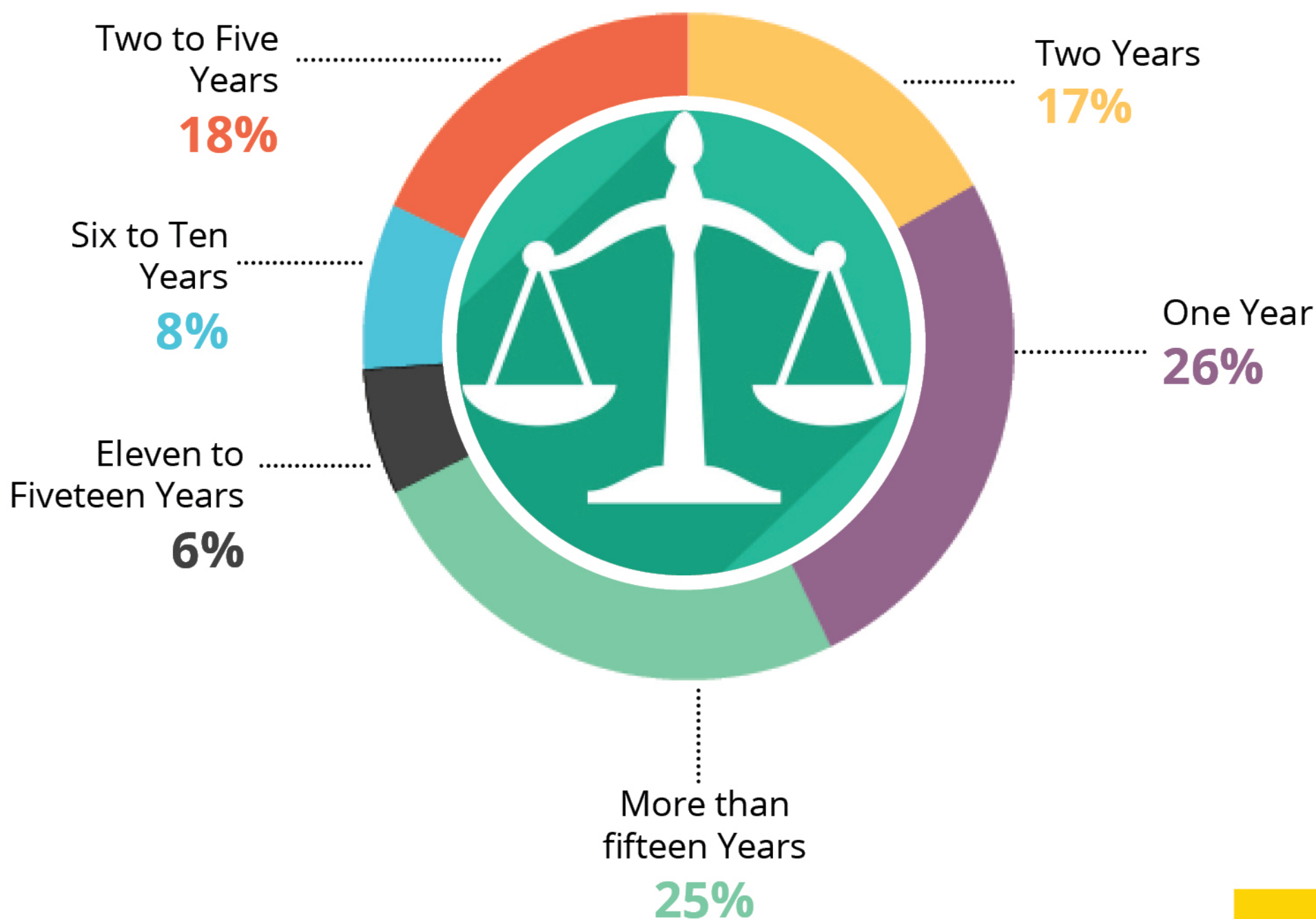

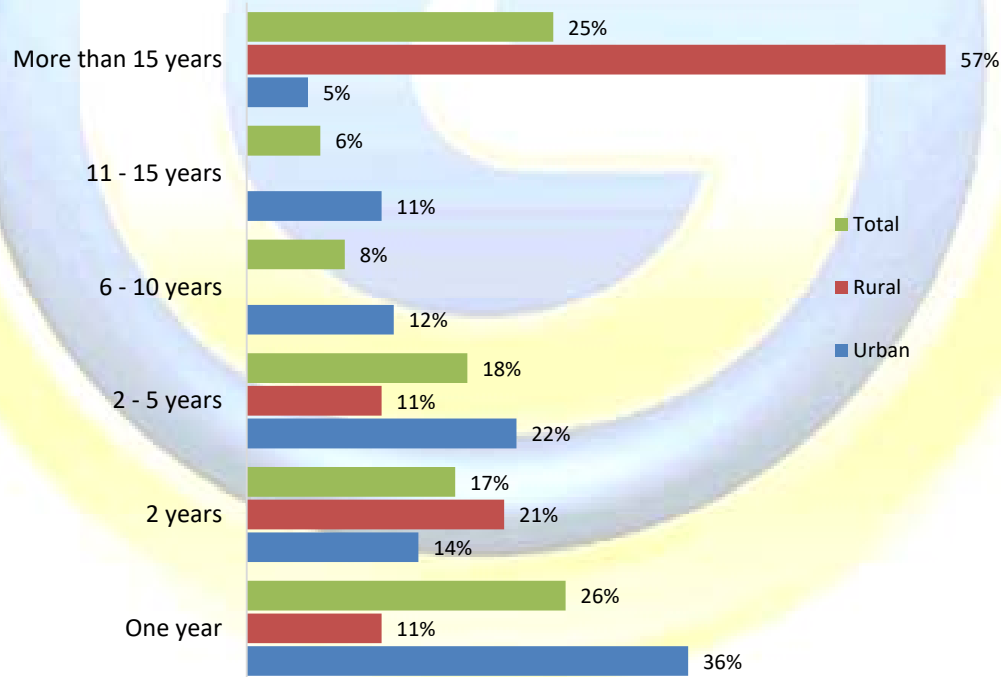
According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 25% Pakistanis claim that their case in court has been going on for over fifteen years.

A representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “How long has a case filed by you/against you in court been going on for?” In response, 26% said the case had been going on for a year and 25% said more than 15 years.

Urban-Rural Breakdown: A high 57% rural respondents claim the case has been going on for more than 15 years

Out of the total rural respondents, 57% claim they have a case going on for more than 15 years compared to only 5% of urban respondents.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,208 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during February 08 - February 15, 2020. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2-3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
