GALLUP PAKISTAN POLL FINDINGS ON

TRAINS ARE THE SAFEST AND MOTORCYCLES ARE THE MOST HAZARDOUS

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*TRAINS ARE THE SAFEST AND MOTORCYCLES
ARE THE MOST HAZARDOUS*

According to a recent Gallup poll motorcycles are considered to be the most risk-prone or hazardous means of transportation. Wagons (mini-bus) are considered second most risk prone followed by rickshaws and buses in that order. Trains are considered the least risk- prone while aero-planes are viewed as having slightly higher risk of accidents than trains. The survey was conducted by Gallup Pakistan with a statistically selected sample of households in the urban areas all over the country covering all provinces of Pakistan. The findings were computer processed. The respondents in the survey were asked to rate various public and private means of transportation on a risk-prone scale ranging from 1 to 9. The average scores received by various transportation means were as follows: motorcycle: 7; 6, motor-rickshaw: 5, bus: 5, Airplane; train: 2, bicycle: 2.
