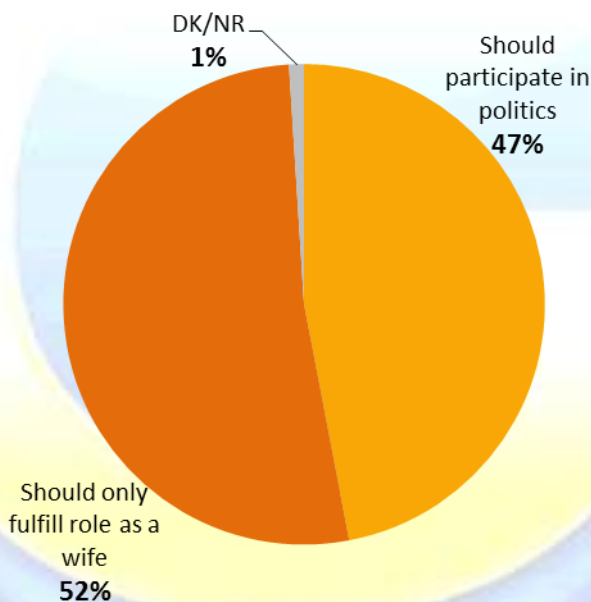
Public opinion divided over whether Reham Khan should participate in politics. GILANI RESEARCH FOUNDATION (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, February 18, 2015

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 47% Pakistanis feel that Reham Khan should participate in politics; 52% disagree.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, from across the four provinces was asked, "Some people think that Reham Khan should help Imran Khan by participating in politics, while others think that she should only fulfill her role as a wife. What is your opinion?" In response to this question, 47% respondents said that Reham Khan should help Imran Khan by participating in politics, while 52% think that she should only fulfill her role as a wife and 1% did not respond.

Question: "Some people think that Reham Khan should help Imran Khan by participating in politics, while others think that she should only fulfill her role as a wife. What is your opinion?"

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1389 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during January 19 - January 26, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

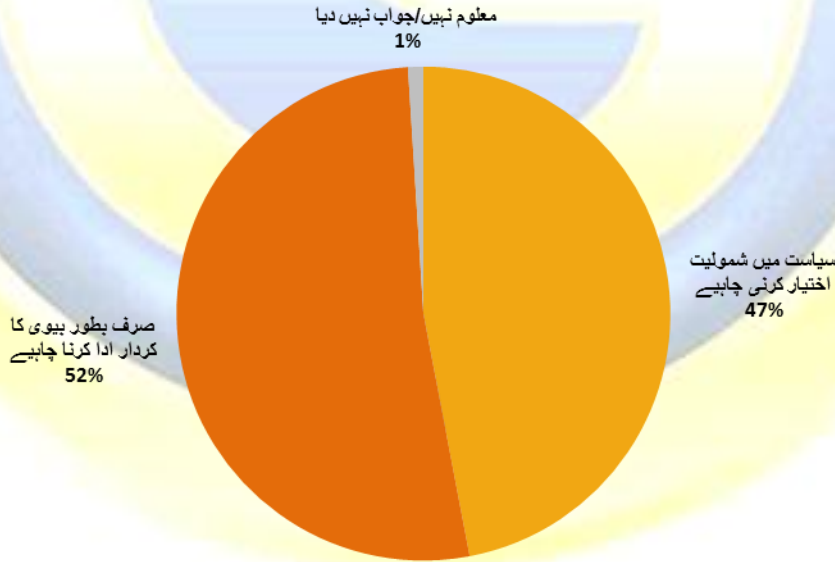

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایک حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 47% پاکستانی سمجھتے ہیں کہ ریحام خان کو سیاست میں شمولیت اختیار کرنی چاہیے، 52% افراد اس بات سے غیر متفق ہیں۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شریاتی طور پر منتخب مرد و خواتین سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "بعض افراد کے خیال میں ریحام خان کو سیاست میں شمولیت اختیار کر کے عمران خان کی مدد کرنی چاہیے، جبکہ بعض افراد کے خیال میں ریحام خان کو صرف بطور بیوی اپنا کردار ادا کرنا چاہیے۔ آپ کی کیا رائے ہے؟" اس سوال کے جواب میں 47% جوابدہندگان کا کہنا ہے کہ ریحام خان کو سیاست میں شمولیت اختیار کرنی چاہیے، جبکہ 52% افراد کے مطابق ریحام خان کو سیاست میں شمولیت اختیار نہیں کرنی چاہیے بلکہ صرف بطور بیوی کا کردار ادا کرنا چاہیے۔ تاہم 1% افراد نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔
