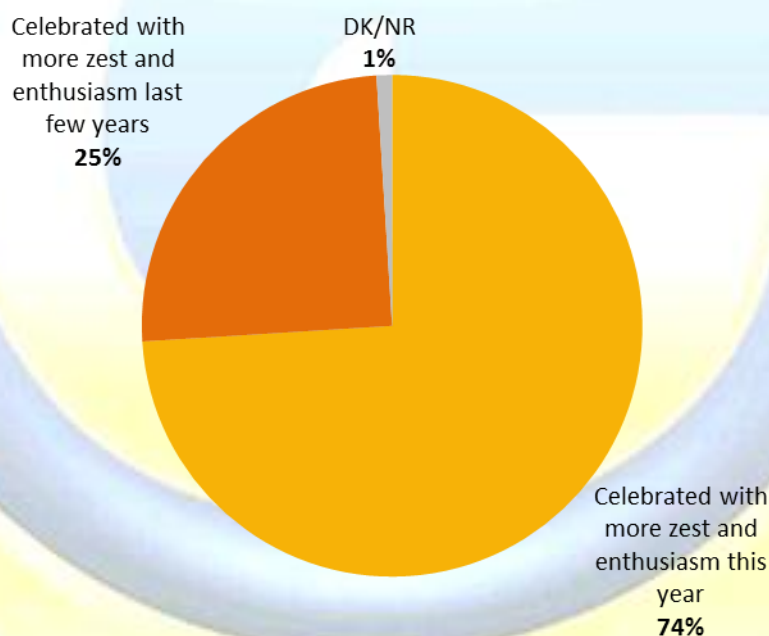

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 74% Pakistanis believe Pakistan Resolution Day was celebrated with more enthusiasm this year as compared to last few years; 25% disagree.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, from across the four provinces was asked, "Some people think that Pakistan Resolution Day was celebrated with more zest and enthusiasm this year as compared to before. Whereas, other people think that there was not much difference in the celebration. What is your opinion regarding this?" In response to this question, 74% respondents said that Pakistan Resolution Day was celebrated with more zest and enthusiasm this year, while 25% respondents said that it was celebrated more enthusiastically last few years and 1% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1123 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during April 06- April 13, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

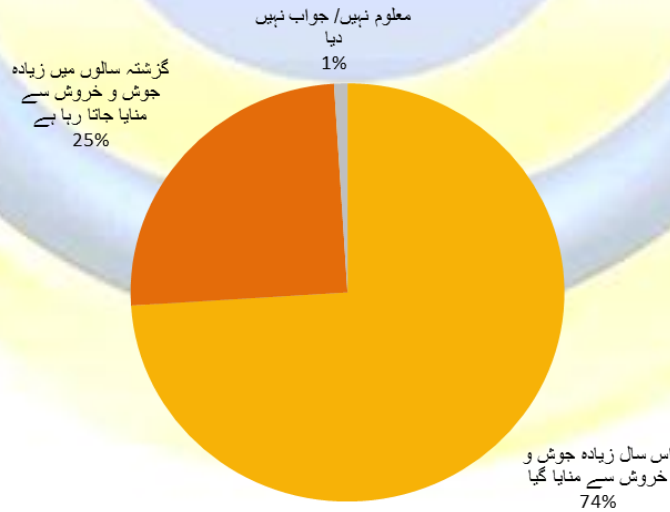

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایک حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 74% پاکستانی سمجھتے ہیں کہ گزشتہ سالوں کے مقابلے میں اس سال یوم پاکستان زیادہ جوش و خروش سے منایا گیا، 25% افراد اس سے غیر متفق ہیں۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شریاتی طور پر منتخب خواتین و حضرات سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "بعض لوگوں کا کہنا ہے کہ اس سال یوم پاکستان گزشتہ سالوں کی نسبت زیادہ جوش و خروش سے منایا گیا۔ جبکہ بعض افراد کہتے ہیں کہ کوئی خاص فرق نہیں دیکھنے میں آیا۔ آپ کی اس بارے میں کیا رائے ہے؟" اس سوال کے جواب میں 74% جوابدہندگان کا کہنا ہے کہ اس سال یوم پاکستان زیادہ جوش و خروش سے منایا گیا، جبکہ 25% جوابدہندگان کے مطابق گزشتہ سالوں میں یوم پاکستان زیادہ جوش و خروش سے منایا جاتا رہا ہے۔ تاہم 1% جوابدہندگان نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔
