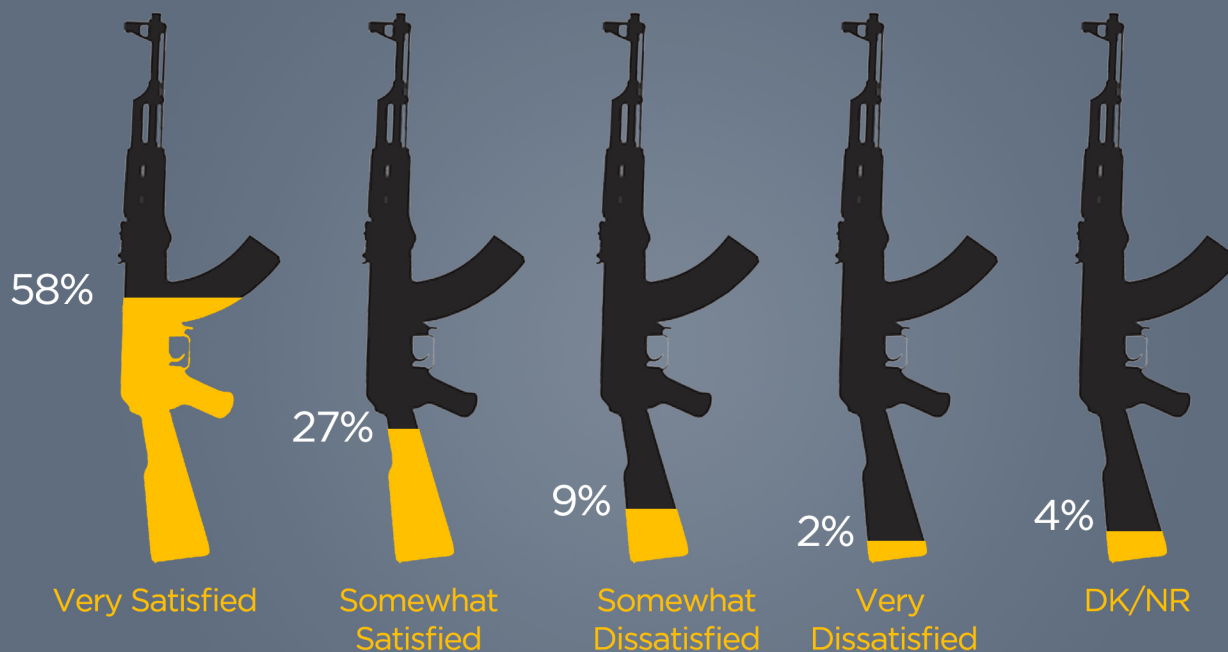


AN OVERWHELMING MAJORITY (85%) OF PAKISTANIS ARE SATISFIED WITH OPERATION ZARB-E-AZAB.

An overwhelming majority (85 %) of Pakistanis are satisfied with operation Zarb-e-Azab. (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, Aug 26, 2015

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 58% Pakistanis are very satisfied by the operation Zarb-e-Azab and 27% are somewhat satisfied by it.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, from across the four provinces was asked, “Regarding the operation Zarb-e-Azab against the Taliban, please tell us how satisfied or dissatisfied you are with the performance of operation Zarb-e-Azab during one year?” In response 58% said that they were very satisfied, 27% said that they were somewhat satisfied while 9% said that they were somewhat dissatisfied and 2% said that they were very dissatisfied. 4% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1899 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 22 – June 29, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.



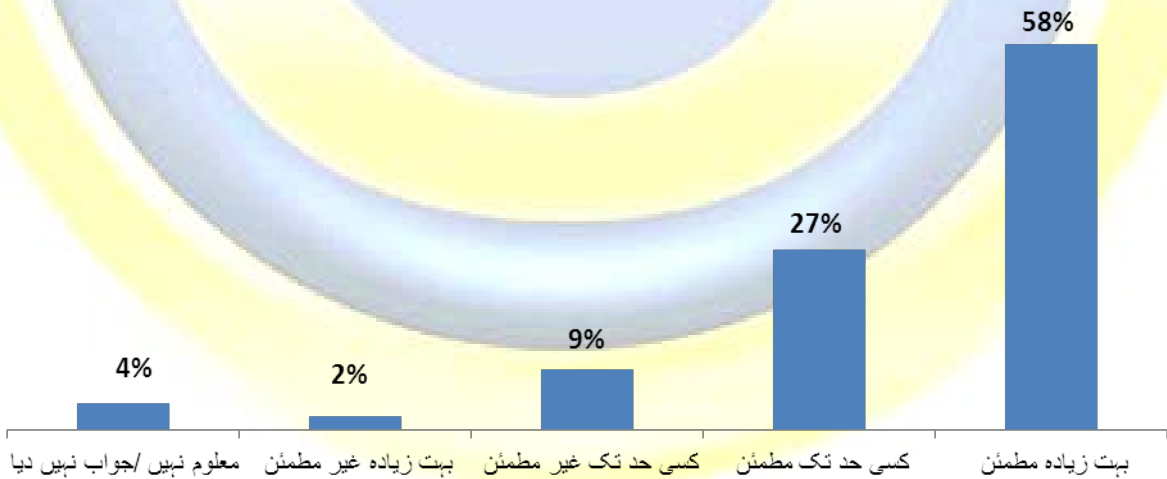

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شاریاتی طور پر منتخب مرد و خواتین سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "برائے مہربانی بتائیں کہ آپ گزشتہ ایک سال کے دوران طالبان کے خلاف جاری آپریشن "ضرب عضب" کی کارکردگی سے کس حد تک مطمئن یا غیر مطمئن ہیں؟"، اس سوال کے جواب میں 58% جوابدہندگان کا کہنا ہے کہ وہ طالبان کے خلاف جاری آپریشن "ضرب عضب" کی کارکردگی سے بہت زیادہ مطمئن ہیں، 27% افراد کے کسی حد تک مطمئن، 9% افراد کے کسی حد تک غیر مطمئن، جبکہ 2% افراد کا کہنا ہے کہ وہ طالبان کے خلاف جاری آپریشن "ضرب عضب" کی کارکردگی سے بہت زیادہ غیر مطمئن ہیں، تاہم 4% نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔
