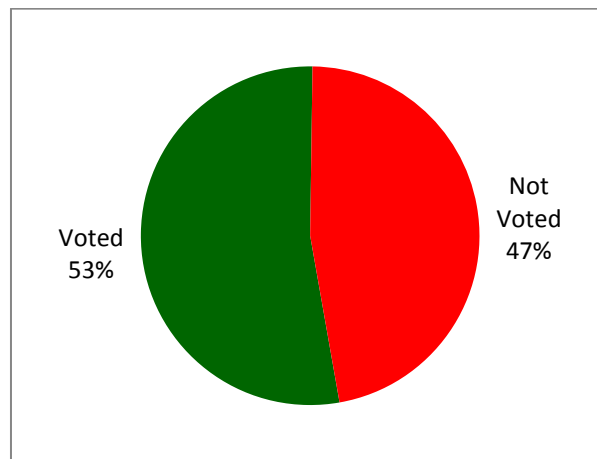

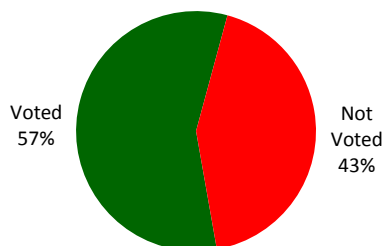
Voter Turn-out at

(53.11 valid and 1.83% Votes which were not valid, would add up to 55.04%)

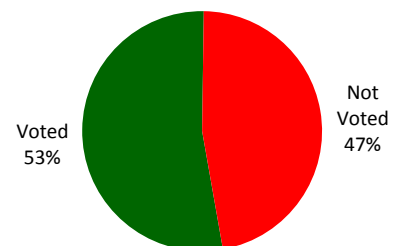


Voter Turnout
PROVINCIAL PICTURE

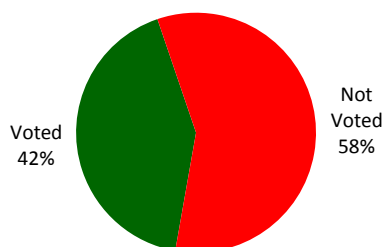

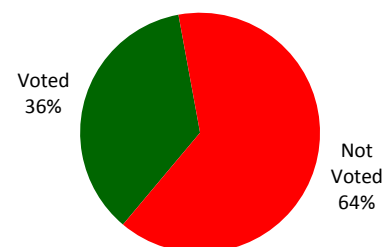
Sindh: 53%

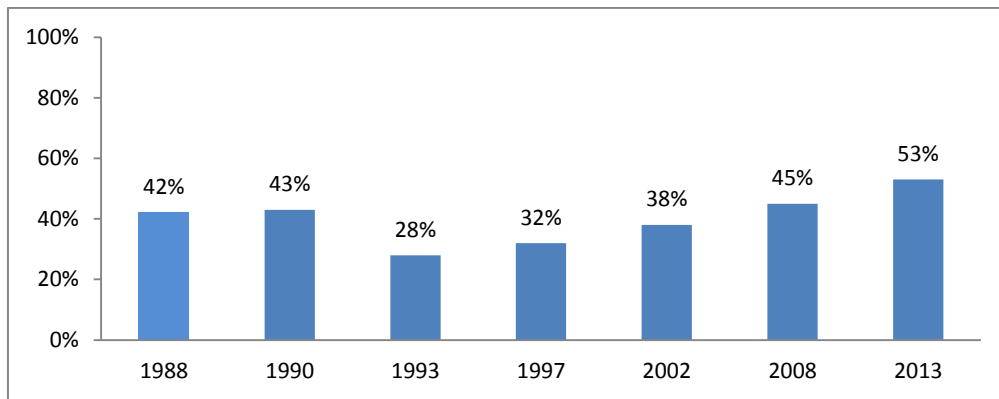

Southern Punjab

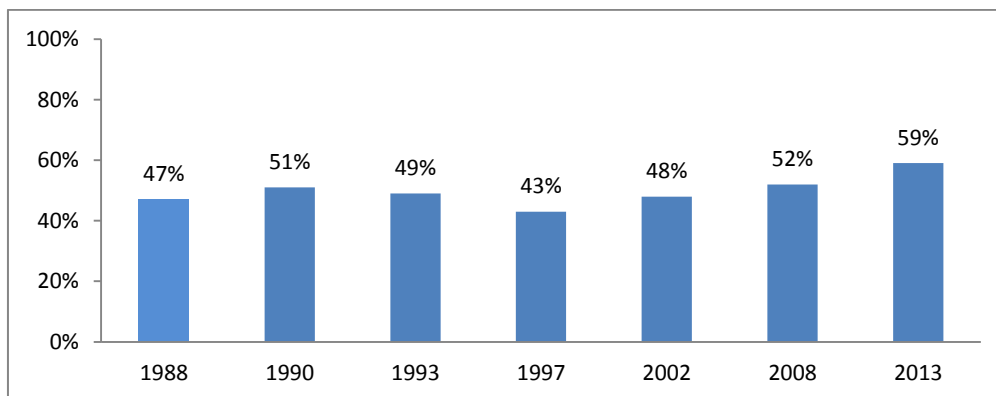


Central & Northern Punjab

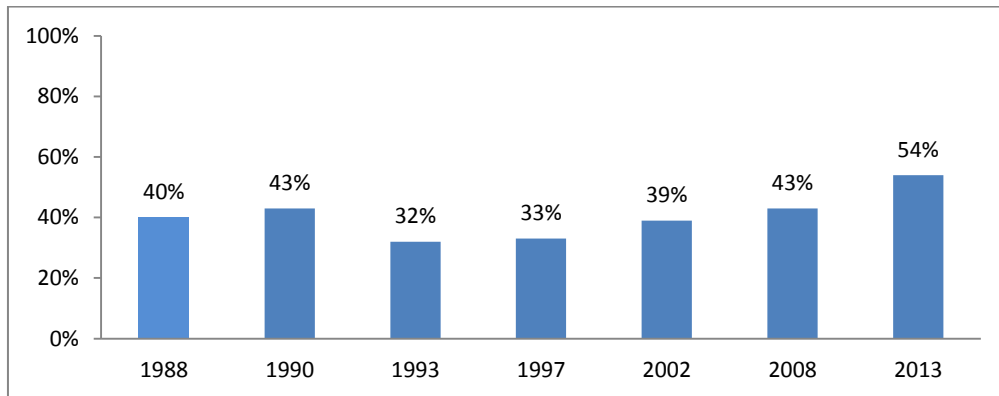


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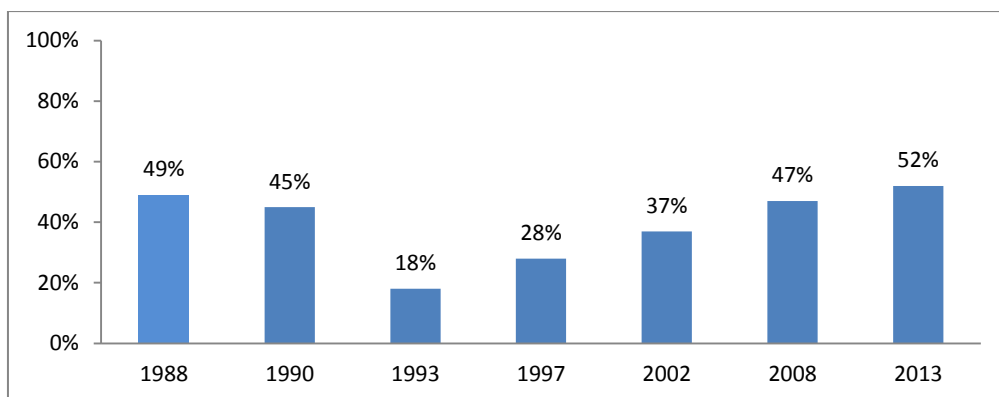

Interior Sindh



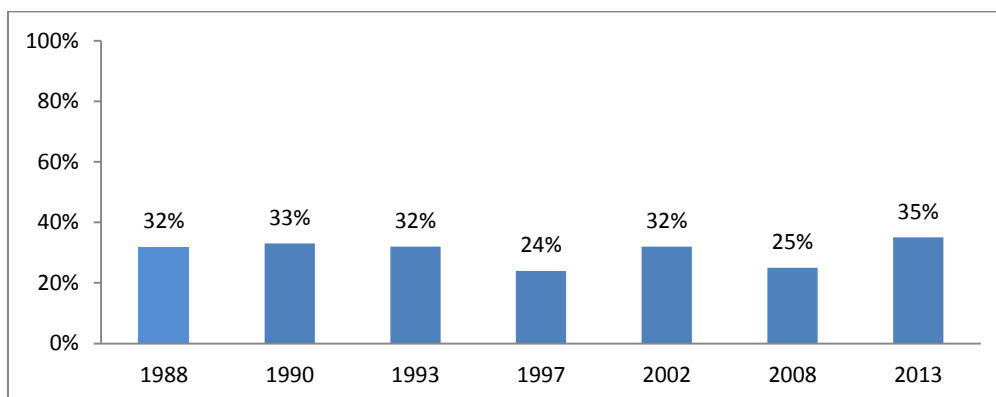

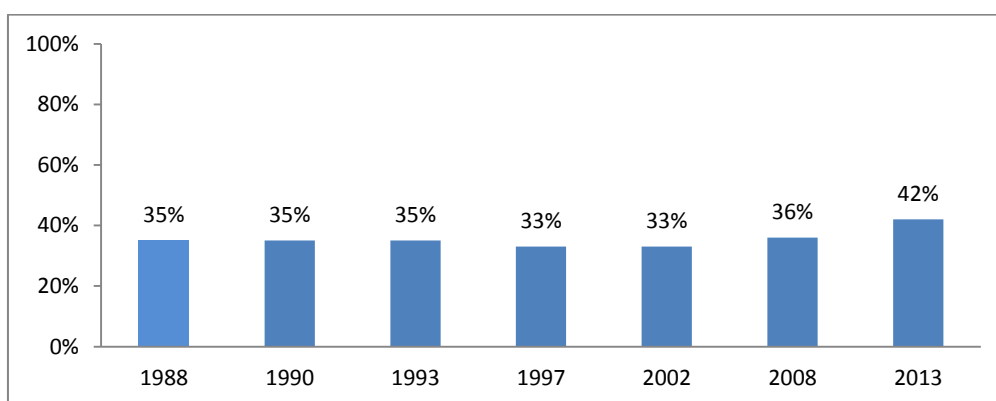

Malakand Region

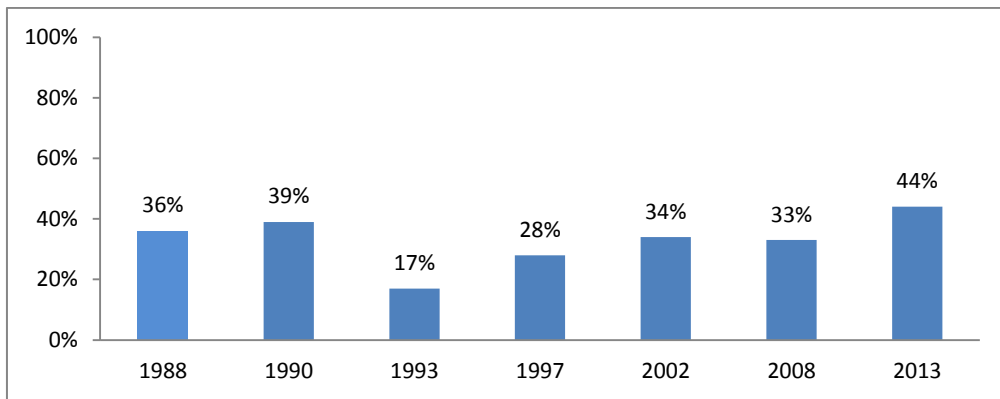

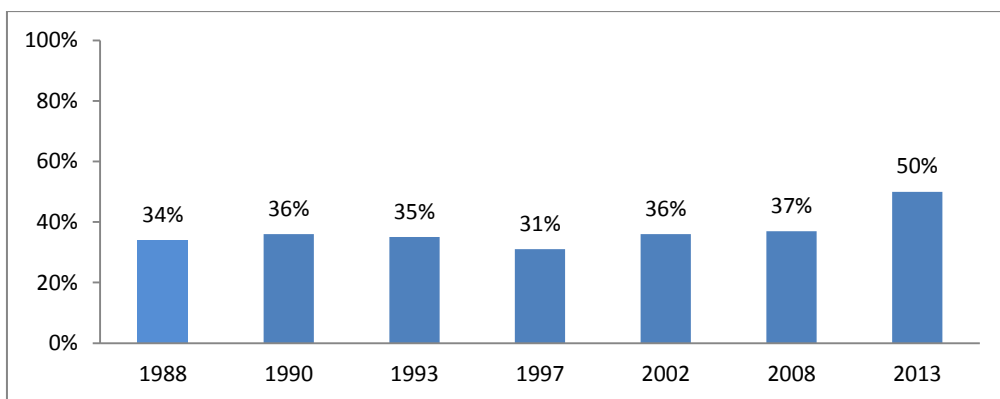

Hazara Region

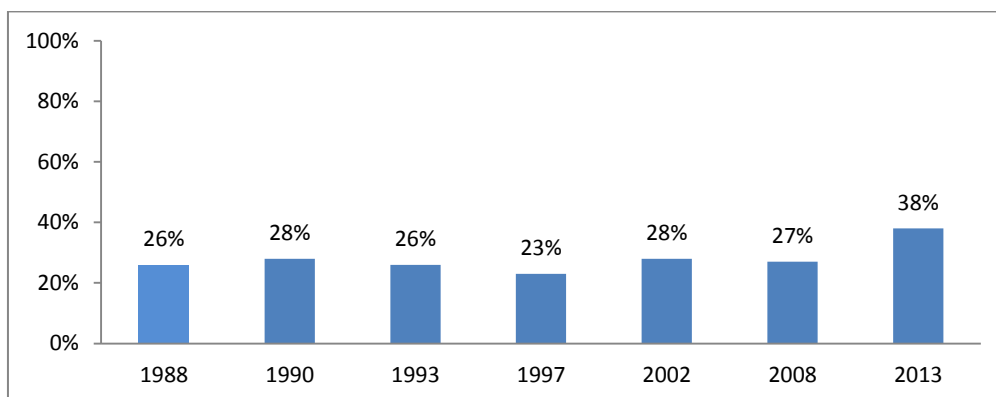


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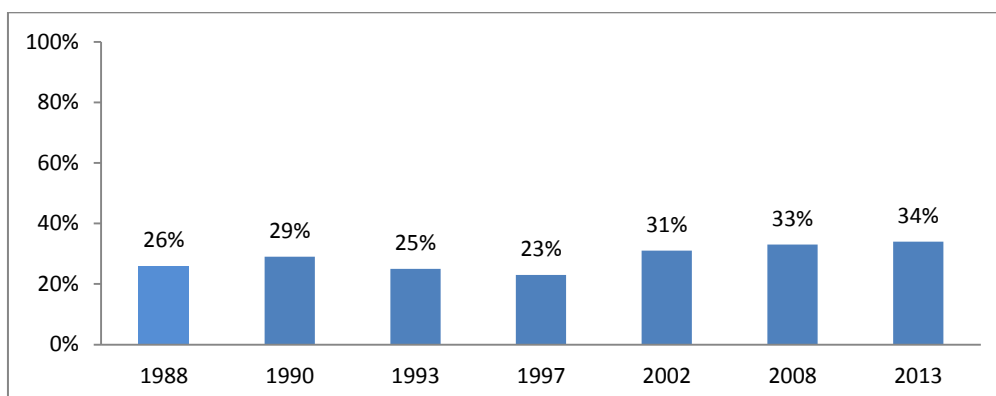

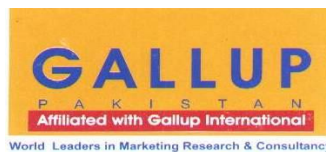
