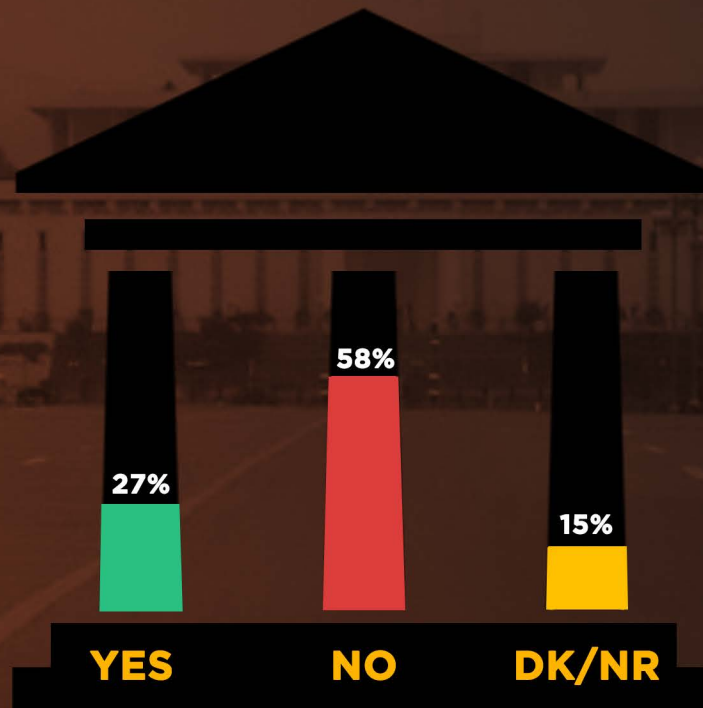


**MORE THAN HALF PAKISTANIS (58%) BELIEVE THAT

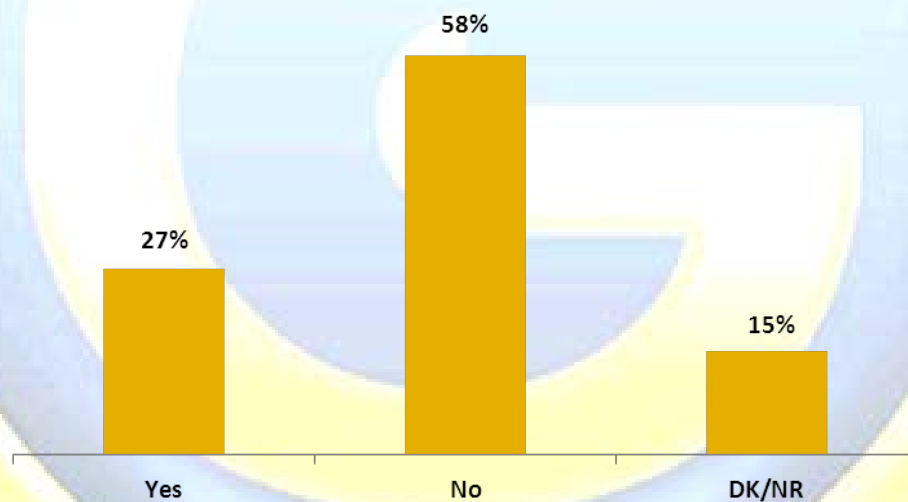
Governance: More than half Pakistanis (58%) believe that government in Pakistan does not run according to the wishes of the people. (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, November 05, 2015

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 58% Pakistanis believe that government in Pakistan does not run according to the wishes of the people.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Do you think the government in our country is run according to the wishes of the people?” In response to this question, only 27% said yes while 58% said no and 15% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1872 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 28 – October 05, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

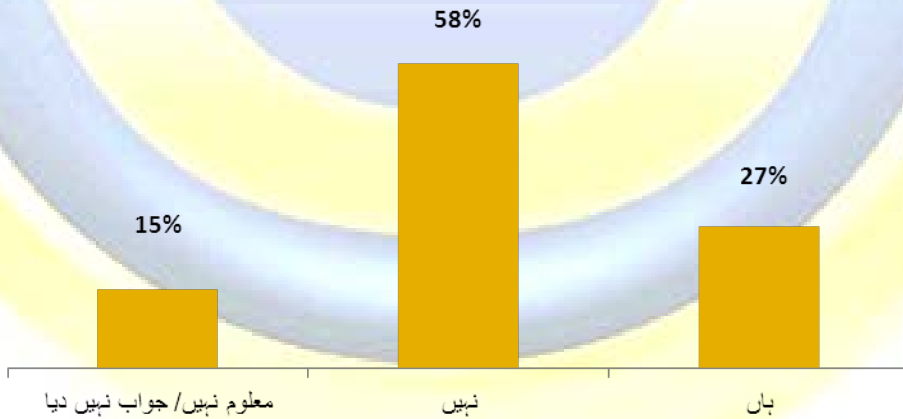

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایک حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 58% پاکستانیوں کے مطابق پاکستان میں حکومت لوگوں کی خواہشات کے مطابق نہیں ہے۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شماریاتی طور پر منتخب خواتین و حضرات سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "آپ کے خیال میں ہمارے ملک میں لوگوں کی خواہشات کے مطابق حکومت ہے یا نہیں؟" اس سوال کے جواب میں صرف 27% جوابدہندگان کا کہنا ہے کہ ہمارے ملک میں لوگوں کی خواہشات کے مطابق حکومت ہے، جبکہ 58% جوابدہندگان کا کہنا ہے کہ ہمارے ملک میں حکومت لوگوں کی خواہشات کے مطابق نہیں ہے، تاہم 15% افراد نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔
