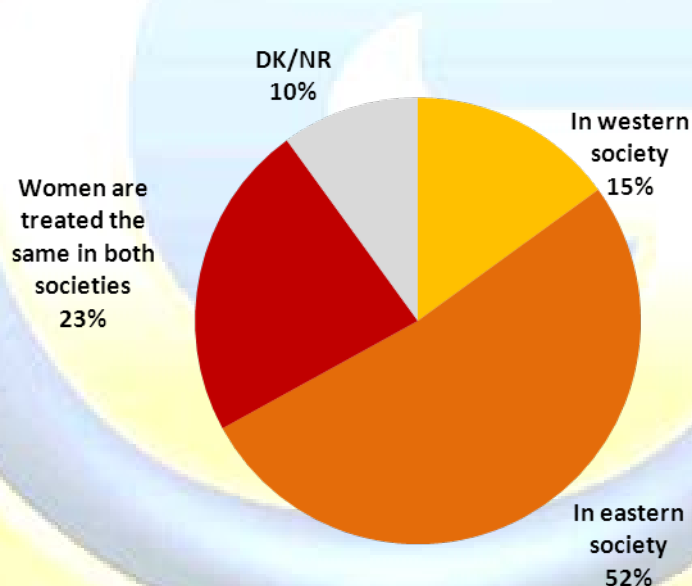
Respect for Women: A slight majority of Pakistanis (52%) believe that women are given more respect in eastern societies compared to western societies. (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, November 11, 2015

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 52% Pakistanis believe that women are given more respect in eastern societies; 15% on the other hand believe that they are given more respect in western societies.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “In your opinion, in which society is a woman respected more? In Western society, eastern society, or are they treated the same in both societies?” In response to this question, 52% said that women are respected more in eastern societies, 15% said that they are respected more in western societies while 23% said that women are treated the same in both societies. 10% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1872 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 28 – October 05, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

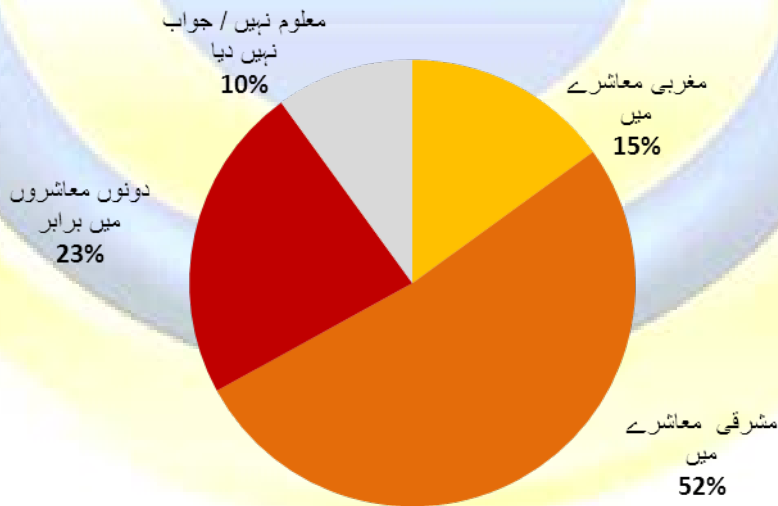

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایک حالیہ سروے کے مطابق 52% پاکستانیوں کے مطابق مشرقی معاشرے میں عورت کو زیادہ عزت دی جاتی ہے، جبکہ دوسری طرف 15% افراد کے مطابق مغربی معاشرے میں عورت کو زیادہ عزت دی جاتی ہے۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شاریاتی طور پر منتخب مرد و خواتین سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "آپ کے خیال میں کس معاشرے میں عورت کو زیادہ عزت دی جاتی ہے؟ مغربی معاشرے میں یا مشرقی معاشرے میں یا دونوں معاشروں میں برابر؟"، اس سوال کے جواب میں 52% جوابدہندگان کے مطابق مشرقی معاشرے میں عورت کو زیادہ عزت دی جاتی ہے، 15% افراد کے مطابق مغربی معاشرے میں عورت کو زیادہ عزت دی جاتی ہے، جبکہ 23% جوابدہندگان کا کہنا ہے کہ دونوں معاشروں میں عورت کو برابر عزت دی جاتی ہے۔ تاہم 10 جوابدہندگان نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔
