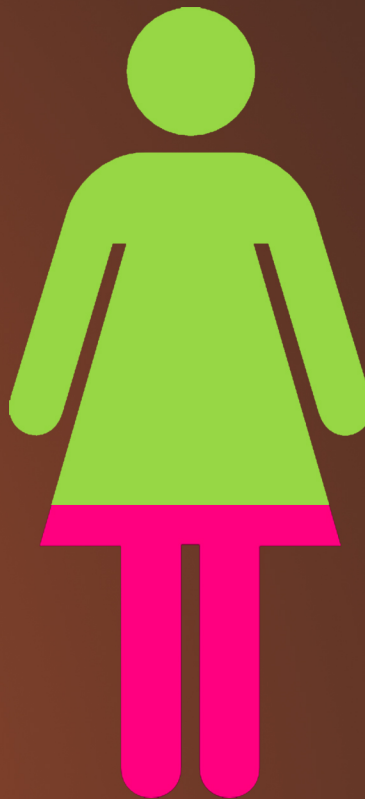

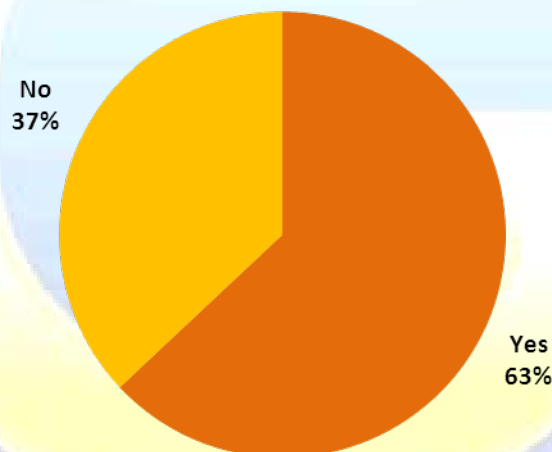
Majority Pakistanis (63%) believe that women should take part in matters pertaining to land in their household. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 63% Pakistanis believe that women should take part in matters pertaining to land in their household.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “In your opinion, should women be involved in matters pertaining to land or not?” In response to this question, 63% respondents said that women should be involved in matters pertaining to land while 37% said that they should not be involved in such matters.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1872 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 28 – October 05, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

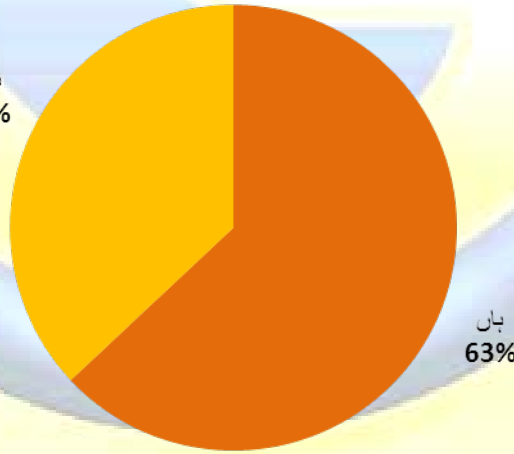

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شاریاتی طور پر منتخب مرد و خواتین سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "آپ کے خیال میں خواتین کو ان معاملات میں شریک ہونا چاہیے یا نہیں؟"، اس سوال کے جواب میں 63% جوابدہندگان کا کہنا ہے کہ "ہاں" خواتین کو زمین کے معاملات میں شریک ہونا چاہیے، جبکہ 37% افراد کے مطابق خواتین کو زمین کے معاملات میں شریک نہیں ہونا چاہیے۔
