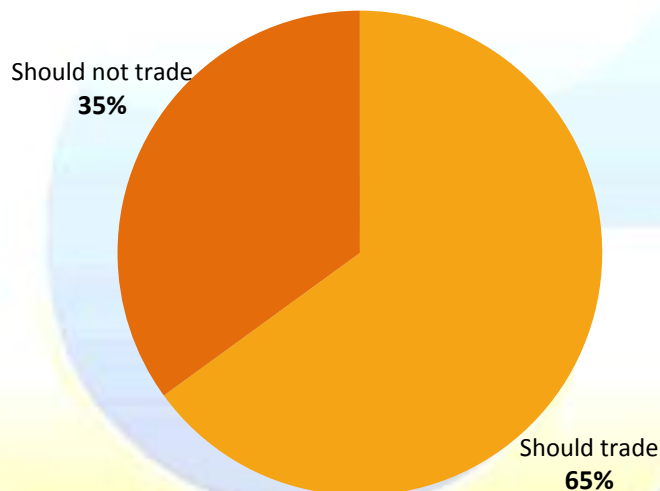
**Most Pakistanis believe that Pakistan should trade with India. GILANI RESEARCH FOUNDATION (GRF POLL)**

Islamabad, December 05, 2014

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 65% Pakistanis believe that Pakistan should trade with India; 35% disagree.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, from across the four provinces was asked, “Do you think Pakistan should trade with India or not?”. In response, 65% respondents said that Pakistan should trade with India and 35% respondents said that Pakistan should not trade with India.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2585 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during November 17 – November 24, 2014. Error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  per cent at 95% confidence level.

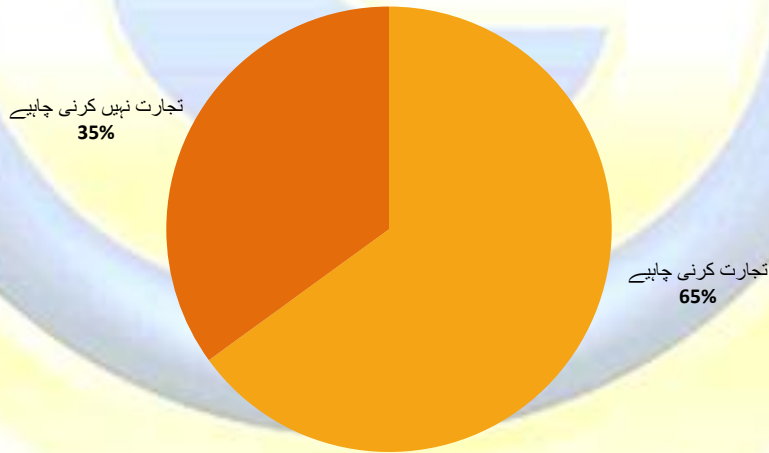

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایک حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 65% پاکستانیوں کا کہنا ہے کہ پاکستان کو بھارت سے تجارت کرنی چاہیے، 35% افراد اس سے غیر متفق ہیں۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شریاتی طور پر منتخب مرد و خواتین سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "آپ کے خیال میں کیا پاکستان کو بھارت سے تجارت کرنی چاہیے یا نہیں؟"۔ اس سوال کے جواب 65% پاکستانیوں کا کہنا ہے کہ پاکستان کو بھارت سے تجارت کرنی چاہیے، جبکہ 35% افراد کے مطابق پاکستانیوں کو بھارت سے تجارت نہیں کرنی چاہیے۔
