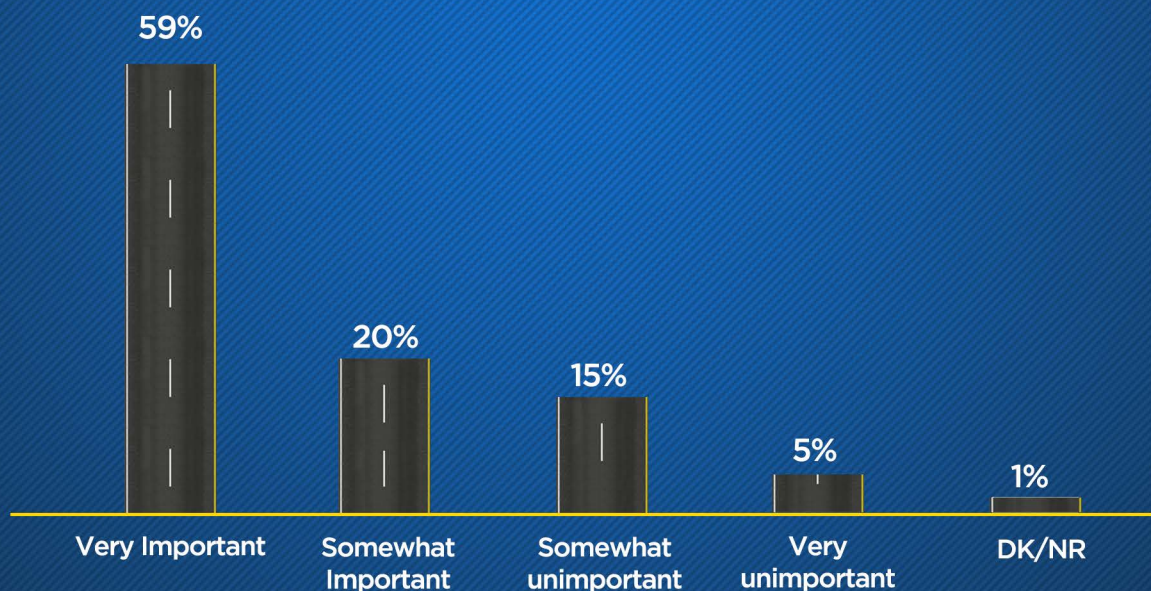

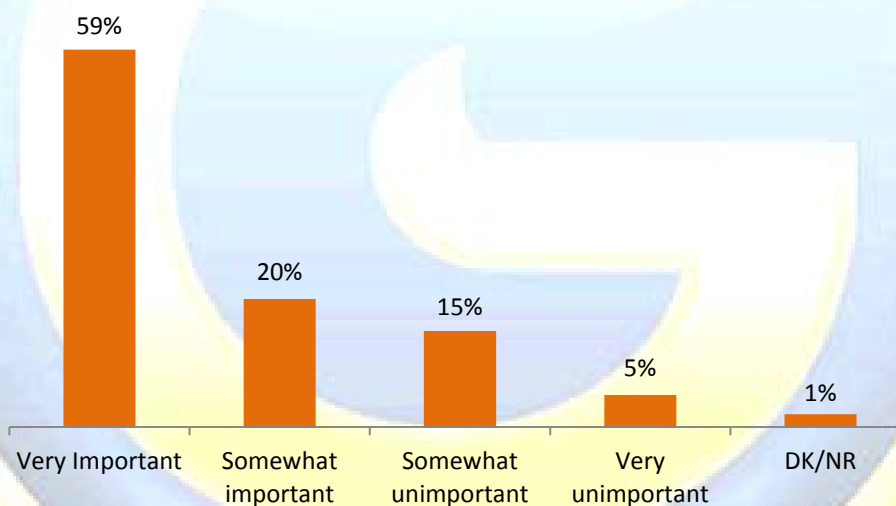
Overwhelming majority of Pakistanis (79 %) believes that Pak-China Economic Corridor is important for Pakistan's development. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 79% Pakistanis believe that Pak-China Economic Corridor is important for Pakistan's development.

A nationally representative sample of men and women who were aware of Pak-China Economic Corridor were asked, "To what extent do you feel that Pak-China Economic Corridor is important for Pakistan's development?" In response to this question 59% said it is very important, 20% said it is somewhat important, 15% said it is somewhat unimportant and 5% said it is completely unimportant. 1% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1052 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during November 02 – November 09, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
