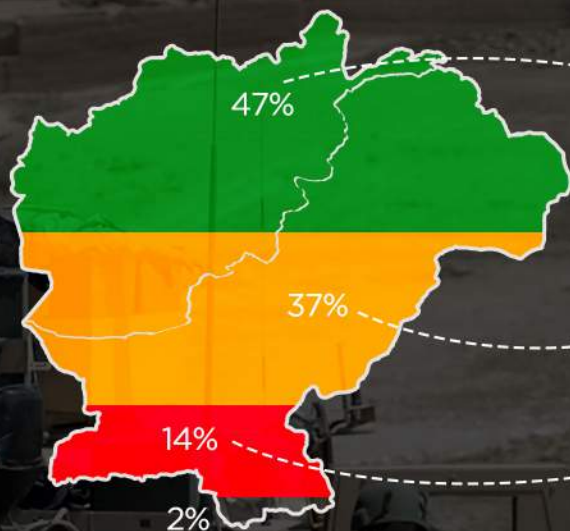


47% PAKISTANIS BELIEVE THAT PAKISTAN HAS SUFFERED MORE LOSSES THAN AFGHANISTAN FROM TERRORISM



47% Pakistanis believe that **Pakistan** has suffered more losses from terrorism.

37% believe that both have suffered **equally**.

14% believe that **Afghanistan** has suffered more losses.

2% of the respondents did not respond.

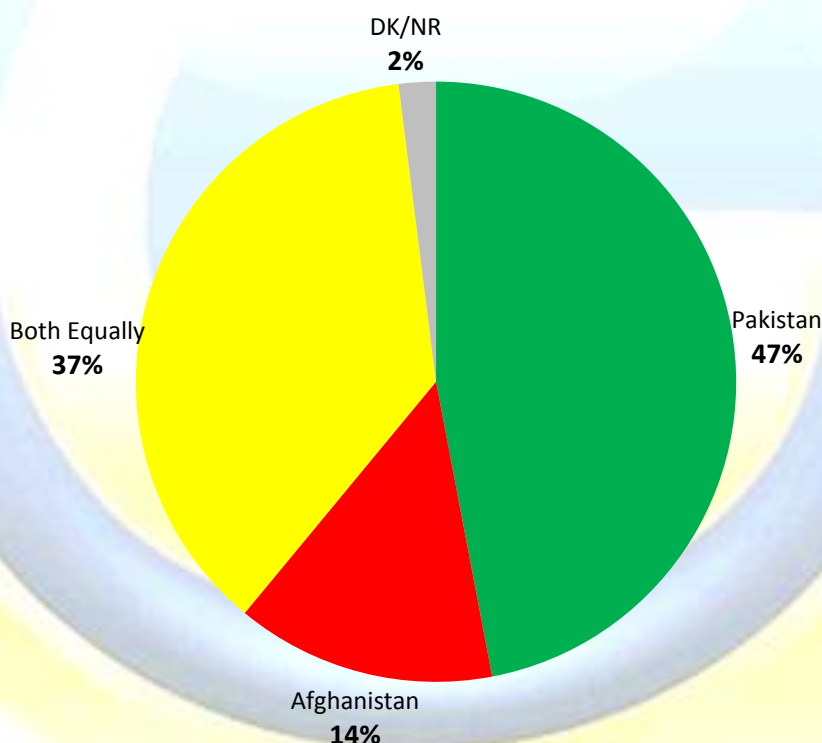
47% Pakistanis believe that Pakistan has suffered more losses than Afghanistan from terrorism. GILANI POLL/GALLUP PAKISTAN

Islamabad, September 2, 2014

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 47% Pakistanis believe that Pakistan has suffered more losses than Afghanistan from terrorism.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, from across the four provinces was asked, “In your opinion, has Pakistan or Afghanistan suffered more losses from terrorism? Has Pakistan suffered more, has Afghanistan suffered more or have both suffered equally?” According to the survey, 47% Pakistanis believe that Pakistan has suffered more losses from terrorism, 14% believe that Afghanistan has suffered more losses, while 37% believe that both have suffered equally. 2% of the respondents did not respond.

Question: “In your opinion, has Pakistan or Afghanistan suffered more losses from terrorism? Has Pakistan suffered more, has Afghanistan suffered more or have both suffered equally?”

The study was released by Gilani Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2656 men in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 14 – July 21, 2014. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

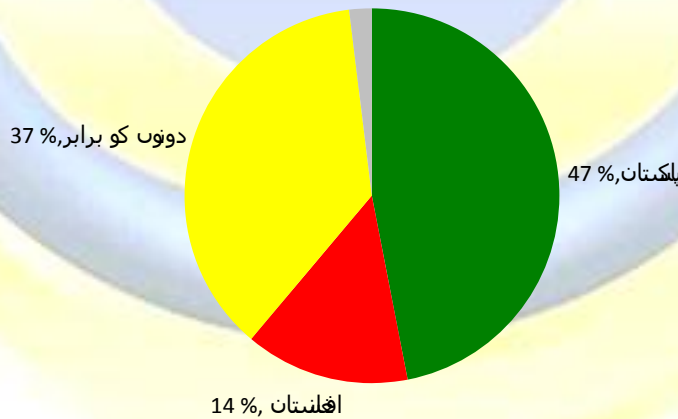

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شماریاتی طور پر منتخب مرد و خواتین سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "آپ کے خیال میں پاکستان اور افغانستان میں سے کس کو دہشت گردی سے زیادہ نقصان پہنچا ہے؟ پاکستان کو افغانستان کو یا دونوں کو برابر نقصان پہنچا ہے؟"، اس سوال کے جواب میں 47% جوابدہندگان کا کہنا ہے کہ پاکستان کو دہشت گردی سے زیادہ نقصان پہنچا ہے، 14% افراد کے مطابق افغانستان کو دہشت گردی سے زیادہ نقصان پہنچا ہے، جبکہ 37% افراد نے کہا کہ دونوں ممالک کو دہشت گردی سے برابر نقصان پہنچا ہے، تاہم 2% نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔
