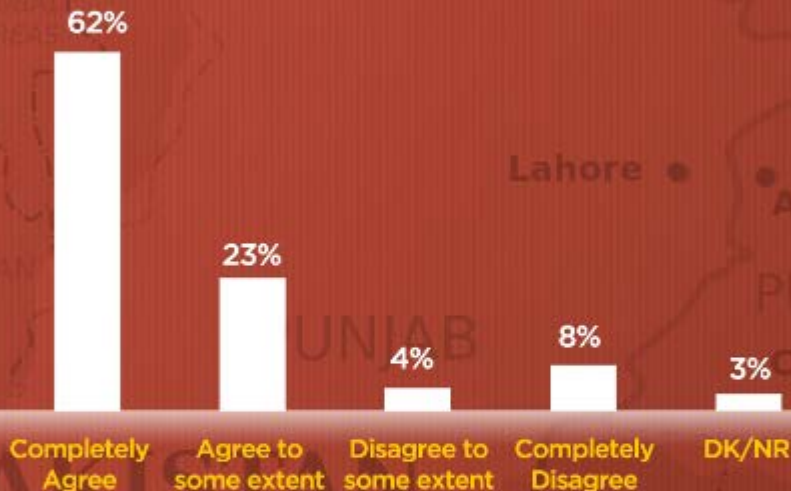


Partition 1947: Majority Pakistanis (85%) agree that if Pakistan was not created, Muslims in India would have lived in great difficulty.

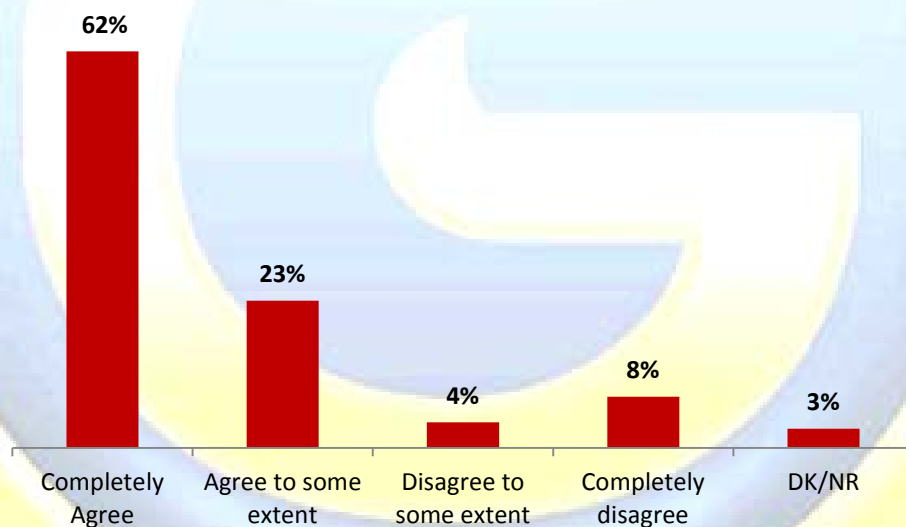
Partition 1947: Majority Pakistanis (85 %) agree that if Pakistan was not created, Muslims in India would have lived in great difficulty. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 85% agree that if Pakistan was not created, Muslims in India would have lived in great difficulty.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement regarding creation of Pakistan: If Pakistan was not created, Muslims in India would have lived in great difficulty?” In response to this question 62% completely agree, 23% agree to some extent, 4% disagree to some extent and 8% disagree. 3% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1756 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during December 07 – December 14, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
