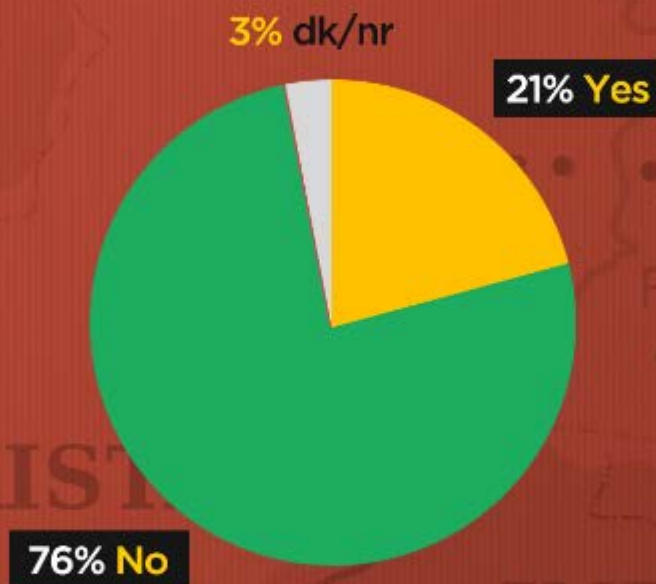


Majority Pakistanis (76%) claim to have never met an Indian citizen in their lifetime.

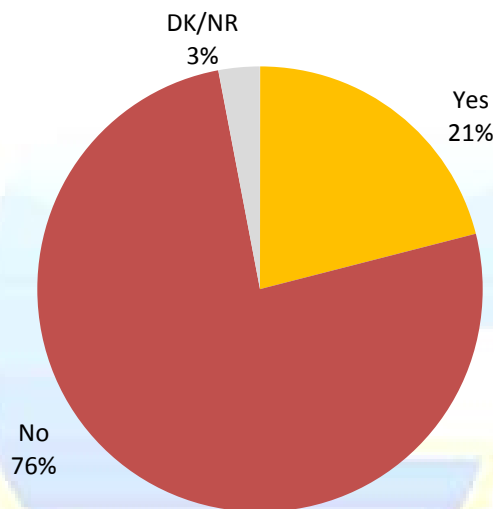
Majority Pakistanis (76 %) claim to have never met an Indian citizen in their lifetime. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 76% Pakistanis claim to have never met an Indian citizen in their lifetime.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Have you ever met an Indian?" In response to this question 76% said no, 21% said yes and 3% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1756 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during December 07 – December 14, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
