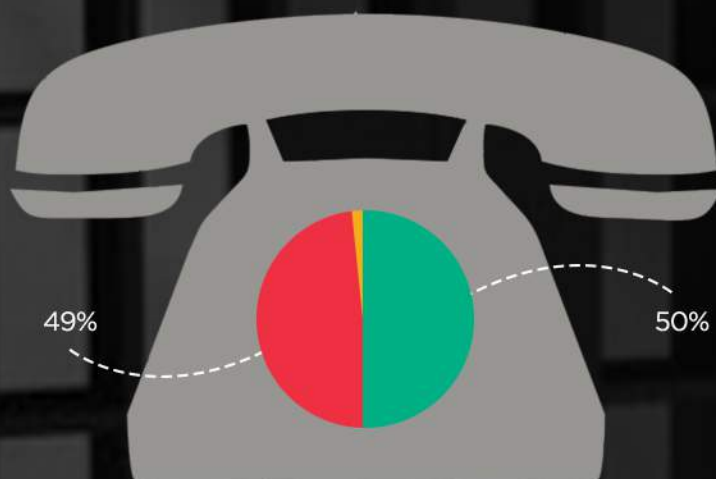

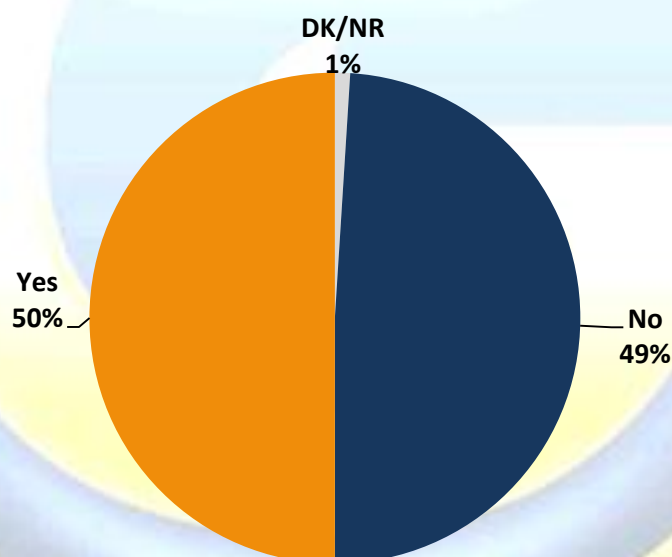
Public opinion split in half about wielding illegitimate influence over custom authorities. GILANI POLL/GALLUP PAKISTAN

Islamabad, September 17, 2014

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 50% Pakistanis would use their contacts to request the release of a friend who has been caught by custom authorities; 49% would not.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, from across the four provinces was asked, "Suppose that one of your friends has been caught by custom authorities at the airport for transporting some goods illegally. Coincidentally you are also friends with a senior officer in customs, so he and his luggage can be released through your request. Will you make a request on his behalf?" Responding to this question 50% Pakistanis said yes, they will make a request on behalf of any friend who has been caught by custom authorities for transporting goods illegally if they could get him released. On the other hand, 49% Pakistanis will not make any such request and 1% did not respond.

Coincidentally you are also friends with a senior officer in customs, so he and his luggage can be released through your request. Will you make a request on his behalf?"

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2618 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 04 – August 11, 2014. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن سے منسلک گیلپ پاکستان کے حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 50% پاکستانی اپنے تعلقات کو استعمال کرتے ہوئے اپنے دوست کو رہا کروانے کے لیے سفارش کریں گے جسے غیر قانونی طور پر کچھ سامان لاتے ہوئے کسٹم والوں نے پکڑ لیا ہو، 49% بالکل بھی سفارش نہیں کریں گے۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شماریاتی طور پر منتخب مرد و خواتین سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "فرض کریں آپ کے ایک دوست کو ایئر پورٹ پر کسٹم والوں نے غیر قانونی طور پر کچھ سامان لاتے ہوئے پکڑ لیا ہے۔ اتفاق سے کسٹم کے اعلیٰ افسر آپ کے دوست ہیں اور آپ کی سفارش سے وہ اور ان کا سامان چھٹ سکتا ہے۔ کیا آپ ان کے لیے سفارش کریں گے؟" اس سوال کے جواب 50% پاکستانیوں کا کہنا ہے کہ "ہاں" وہ اپنے دوست کی سفارش کریں گے اگر اسے ایئر پورٹ پر کسٹم والوں نے غیر قانونی طور پر کچھ سامان لاتے ہوئے پکڑ لیا ہو، جبکہ دوسری طرف 49% افراد کے مطابق وہ اس کی بالکل بھی سفارش نہیں کریں گے، تاہم 1% نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔
