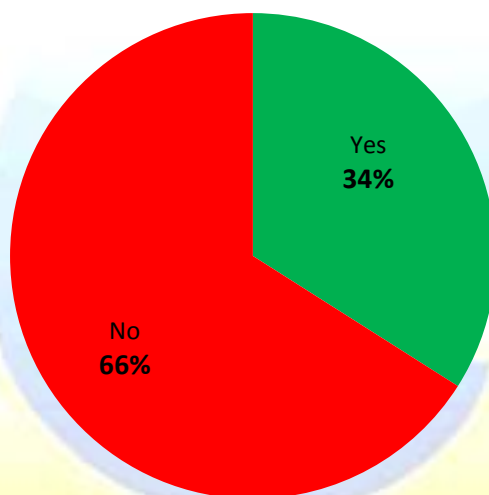
34% Pakistanis say someone has recently asked them for help in charity work. GILANI POLL/GALLUP PAKISTAN

Islamabad, July 21, 2014

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 34% Pakistanis say someone has recently asked them for help in charity work.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, across the four provinces was asked, "Recently has anyone asked for your help for any charity work?" 34% of the respondents said yes, while 66% of the respondents said they had not been asked for any help for charity work.

The study was released by Gilani Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2693 men in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during May 26 - June 02, 2014. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

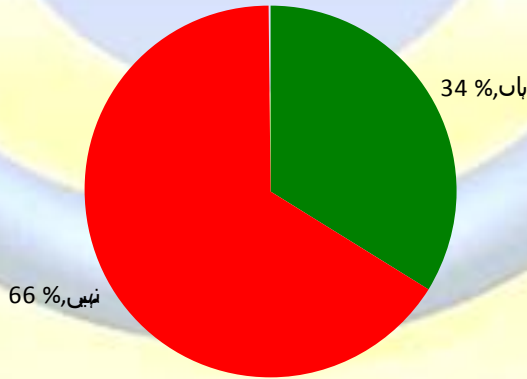

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایک حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 34% پاکستانیوں کا کہنا ہے کہ حالیہ دنوں میں کسی شخص نے اُن سے فلاحی کام کے لیے امداد طلب کی۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شمولیت کی طور پر منتخب مرد و خواتین سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ "کیا حالیہ دنوں میں کسی شخص نے آپ سے کسی فلاحی کام کے لیے امداد طلب کی؟"، اس سوال کے جواب میں 34% جوابدہندگان نے کہا کہ "ہاں" حالیہ دنوں میں کسی شخص نے اُن سے کسی فلاحی کام کے لیے امداد طلب کی، جبکہ 66% جوابدہندگان کے مطابق اُن سے کسی شخص نے فلاحی کام کے لیے امداد طلب نہیں کی۔
