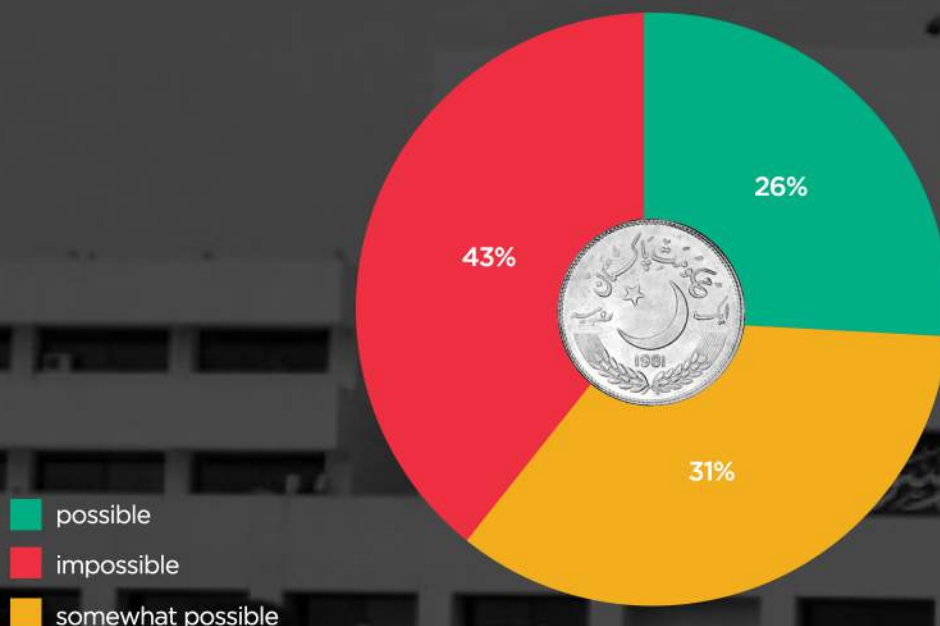

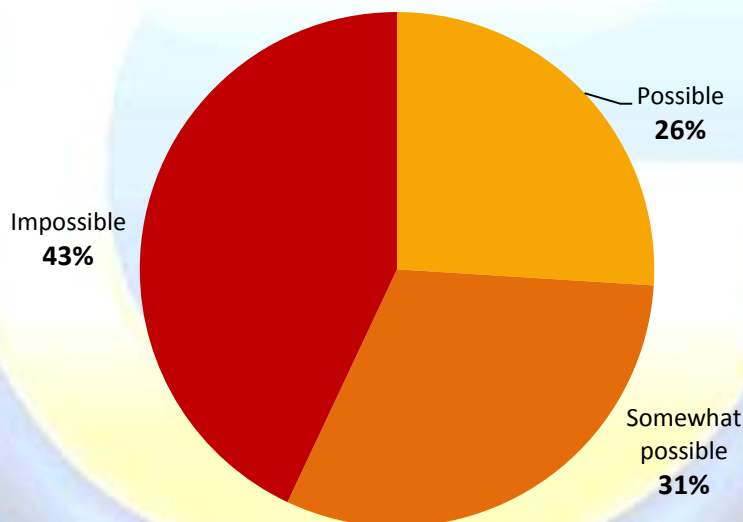
Majority pessimistic about the level of corruption in government departments. GILANI POLL/GALLUP PAKISTAN

Islamabad, September 22, 2014

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 43% Pakistanis think it is impossible to get work done from government departments without illegitimate means.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, from across the four provinces was asked, “Mr. Akram is a businessman. He often needs work done from government departments for the success of his business. Do you think it is possible that he can get his work done without bribery and recommendations?” Responding to this question, 26% Pakistanis said it is possible to get his work done without illegitimate means, 31% said it is somewhat possible and 43% said it is impossible.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2618 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 04 – August 11, 2014. Error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 per cent at 95% confidence level.

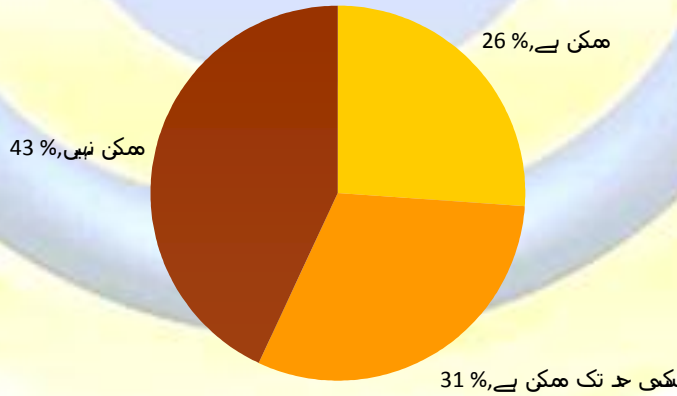
