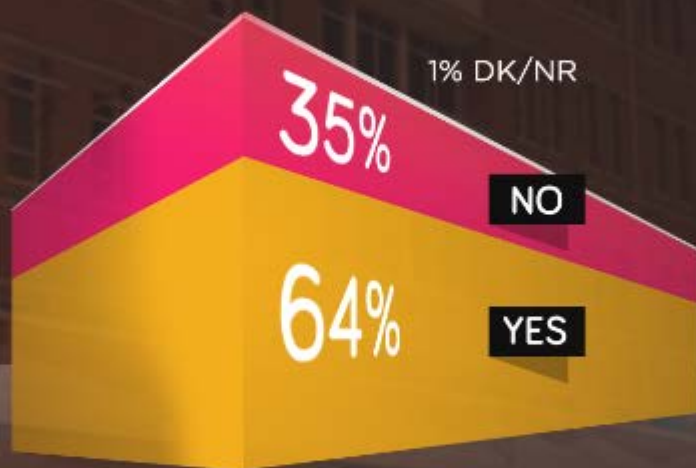

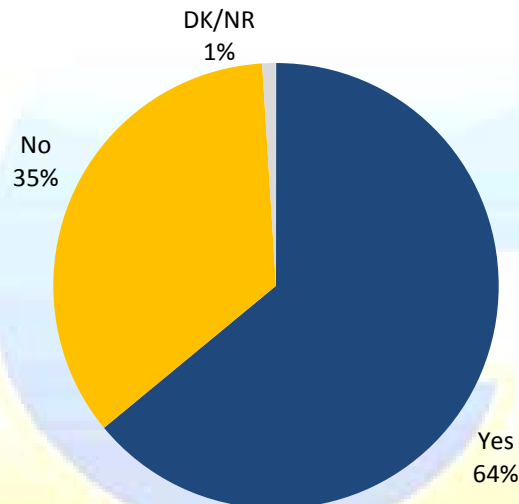
Majority Pakistanis (64 %) claim to have heard/read about the inauguration of Shaukat Khanum Hospital in Peshawar. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 64% Pakistanis claim to have heard/read about the inauguration of Shaukat Khanum Hospital in Peshawar

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Recently, Pakistan Tehreek Insaf chairman Imran Khan inaugurated Shaukat Khanum Hospital in Peshawar. Have you heard or read anything about this?” In response to this question 64% said yes, 35% said no and 1% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1883 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during January 04 – January 11, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
