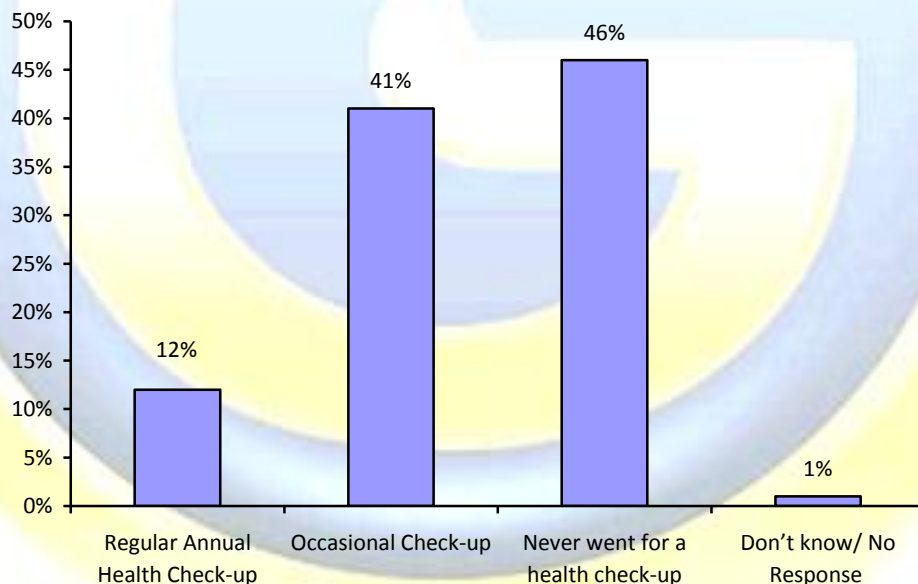
12% of Pakistanis say they undergo annual health check-up.

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan 12% of Pakistanis say they undergo annual health check-up.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked "How often do you go for medical check-up?" Responding to this 12% of Pakistanis undergo annual checkups. Another 41% claim they sometimes or occasionally undergo a health check-up. The remaining 46% say they almost never undergo a health check-up. However 1% did not give a view.

The study was released by Gilani foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2698 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during November 06 - November 12, 2011. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

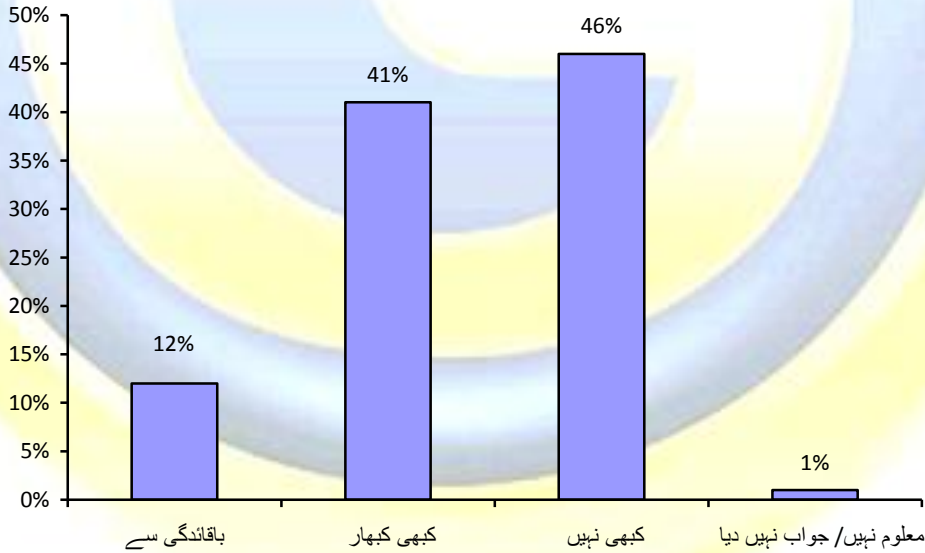

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایکٹ عالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 12% پاکستانیوں نے بتایا کہ وہ باقاعدگی سے اپنا سالانہ میڈیکل چیک اپ کراتے ہیں۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شماریاتی طور پر منتخب خواتین و حضرات سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ کیا آپ اپنا سالانہ میڈیکل چیک اپ کراتے ہیں؟ اس سوال کے جواب میں 12% جوابدہندگان نے بتایا کہ وہ باقاعدگی سے اپنا سالانہ میڈیکل چیک اپ کراتے ہیں، 41% کبھی کبھار جبکہ 46% نے کبھی اپنا سالانہ میڈیکل چیک اپ نہیں کرایا، بتایا 1% نے کوئی جواب نہیں دیا۔
