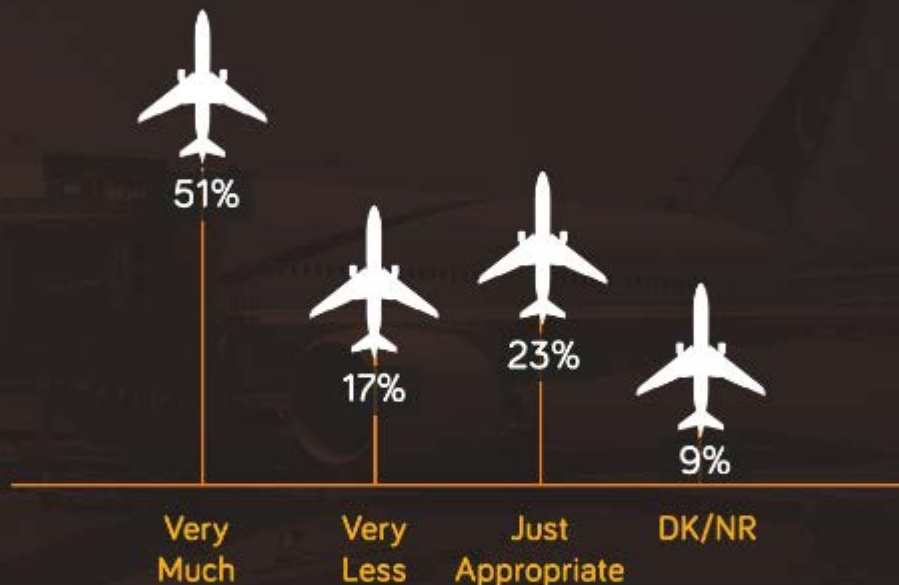

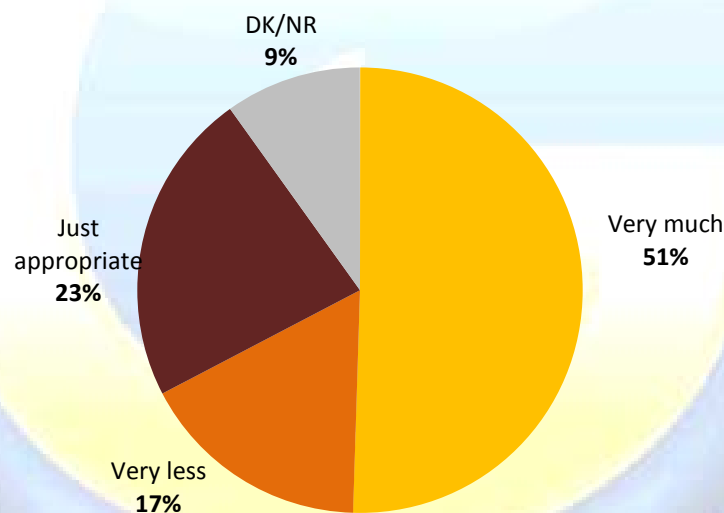
More than half Pakistanis (51 %) believe that Prime Minister is spending too much time on foreign tours. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 51% Pakistanis believe that Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif is spending a lot of time on foreign tours.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Some people are of the opinion that Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif is spending a lot of his time on foreign tours while others say that this is not the case. Please tell, in your opinion is the amount of time spent by Prime Minister on foreign tours very much, very less or just appropriate?” In response, 51% said very much, 17% said very less and 23% said just appropriate. 9% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1826 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during December 21 – December 28, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
