Relief Efforts for Sindh Flood Affectees (Part 3)

This is a 3 part survey on Recent Floods in Sindh province. Part 1 looks at claimed voluntary help by ordinary citizens; part 2 looks at assessment of official relief efforts; part 3 looks at views about responsibility for flood disasters, lack of government efforts or simply nature's doing.

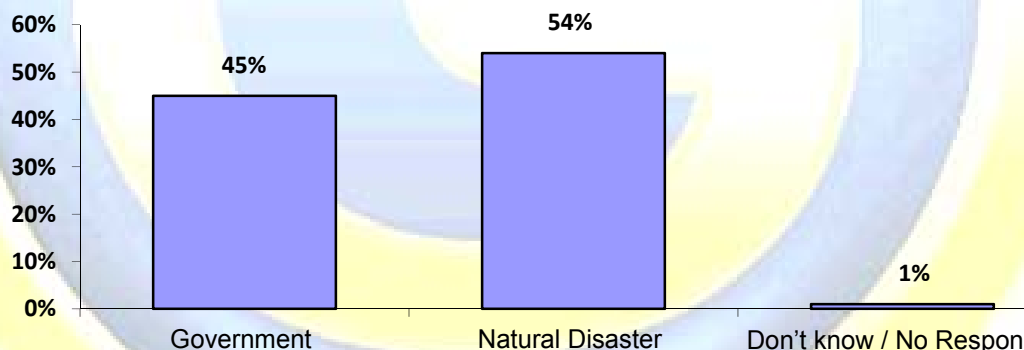

Islamabad, October 10, 2011

The results of a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan revealed that Only Half (45%) blame government for flooding disasters; the other half (54%) regard it as unforeseen natural calamity.

In a survey a nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces were asked the following question: "In your opinion who is responsible for the damage in Sindh due to recent floods?" Responding to this, only 45% blame the government for flooding disaster in Sindh where as 54% consider it as a natural disaster. However 1% did not give a view.

The study was released by Gilani foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2721 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 18-September 24, 2011. Error margin is estimated to be approximately + 2-3 per cent at 95% confidence level.

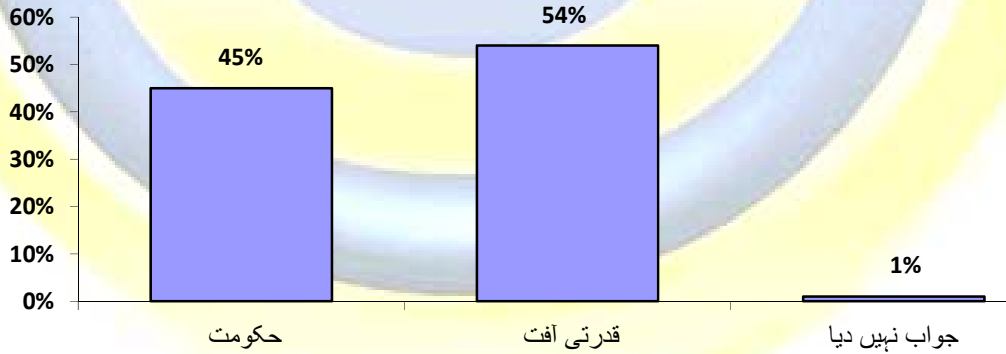

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایک حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، صرف نصف (45%) افراد کے خیال میں سیلاب کی ذمہ دار حکومت ہے، دیگر نصف (54%) افراد کے خیال میں یہ قدرتی آفت ہے۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شاریاتی طور پر منتخب خواتین و حضرات سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "حالیہ سیلاب سے صوبہ سندھ میں جوتباہی ہوئی ہیں، آپ کے خیال میں ان کا ذمہ دار کون ہے؟"، جس کے جواب میں صرف (45%) افراد کے مطابق سندھ میں سیلاب کی ذمہ دار حکومت ہے، جبکہ 54% کے خیال میں یہ قدرتی آفت ہے، تاہم 1% نے کوئی جواب نہیں دیا۔

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کا حالیہ سروے گیلپ انٹرنیشنل سے منسلک گیلپ پاکستان کی مدد سے کیا گیا۔ یہ سروے پاکستان کے چاروں صوبوں کی دیہی اور شہری آبادی کے 2721 مرد اور خواتین سے 18 ستمبر سے 24 ستمبر 2011 میں منعقد ہوا۔ غلطی کے امکان کا تخمینہ شاریاتی طور پر تقریباً $\pm 2-3\%$ لگایا گیا ہے۔
