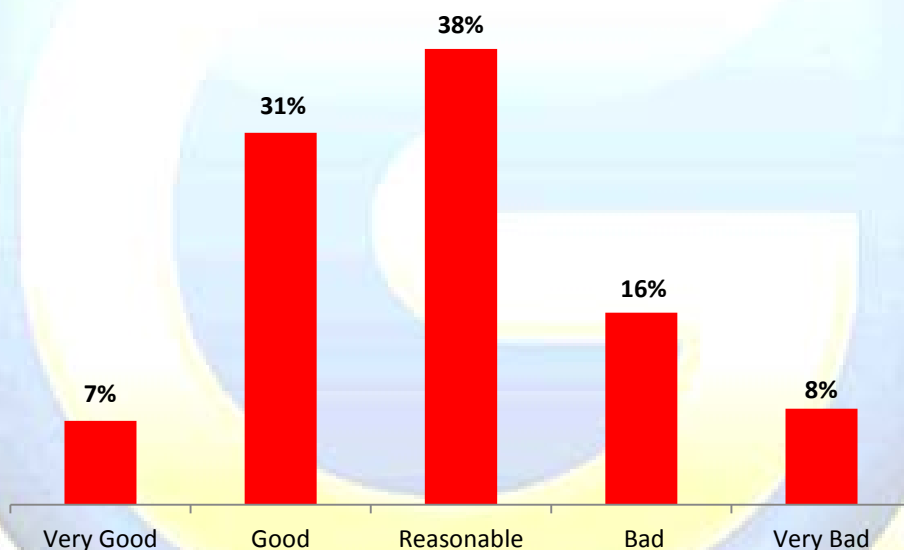
38 % Pakistanis opine that the performance of members of National Assembly is reasonable. (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, February 11, 2016

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 38% Pakistanis opine that the performance of members of National Assembly is reasonable; 38% also opined that performance of National Assembly members is good.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Please tell, what is your opinion about the performance of members of National assembly?” In response, 7% said that performance of National Assembly members is very good, 31% said that it is good, 38% said that it is reasonable, 16% said that it is bad and 8% said that it is very bad.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1826 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during December 21 – December 28, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
