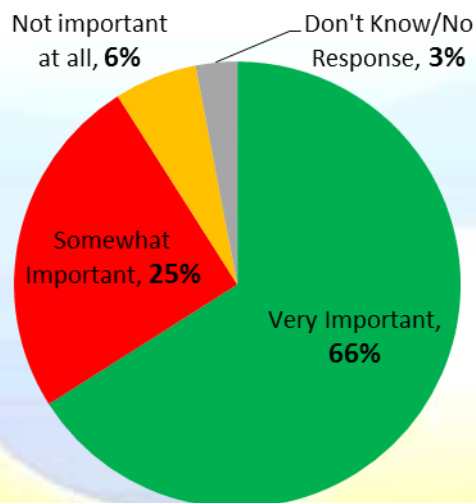
66% of Pakistanis think it is very important for the Kashmir issue to be resolved. GILANI POLL/GALLUP PAKISTAN

Islamabad, December 12, 2012

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 66% of Pakistanis think it is very important for the Kashmir issue to be resolved.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “In your opinion, how important is the resolution of the Kashmir issue?” Responding to this, 66% consider it very important, 25% consider it somewhat important and 6% consider it not important at all. However, 3% did not give a response.

The study was released by Gilani foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2677 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during November 18, 2012 – November 25, 2012. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

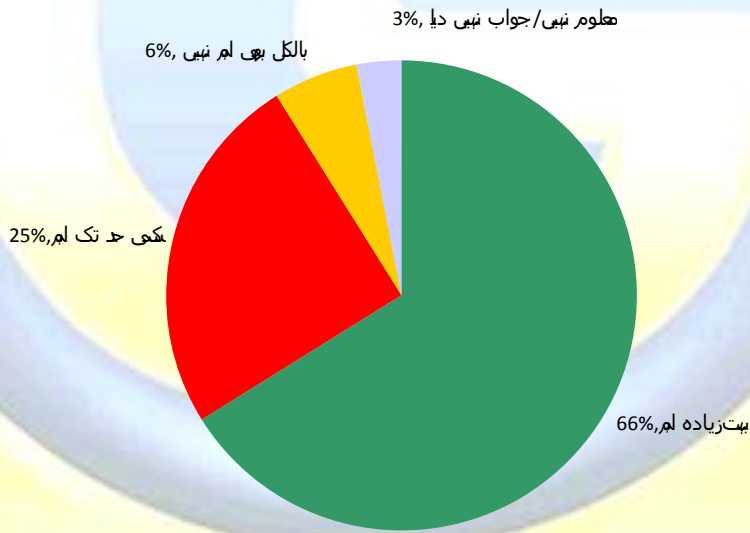

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایک حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 66% پاکستانیوں کے مطابق مسئلہ کشمیر کا حل بہت زیادہ اہم ہے۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شمولیت کی طور پر منتخب مرد و خواتین سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "آپ کے خیال میں مسئلہ کشمیر کا حل کس حد تک اہم ہے؟"، اس سوال کے جواب میں 66% جوابدہندگان کے مطابق مسئلہ کشمیر کا حل بہت اہم ہے، 25% کے مطابق مسئلہ کشمیر کا حل کسی حد تک اہم ہے اور 6% کے مطابق مسئلہ کشمیر کا حل بالکل بھی اہم نہیں۔ تاہم 3% نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔

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گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کا حالیہ سروے گلیپ انٹرنیشنل سے منسلک گلیپ پاکستان کی مدد سے کیا گیا۔ یہ سروے پاکستان کے چاروں صوبوں کی دیہی اور شہری آبادی کے 2677 مرد و خواتین سے 18 نومبر تا 25 نومبر 2012 میں منعقد ہوا۔ غلطی کے امکان کا تخمینہ شماریاتی طور پر تقریباً $\pm 2-3\%$ لگایا گیا ہے۔
