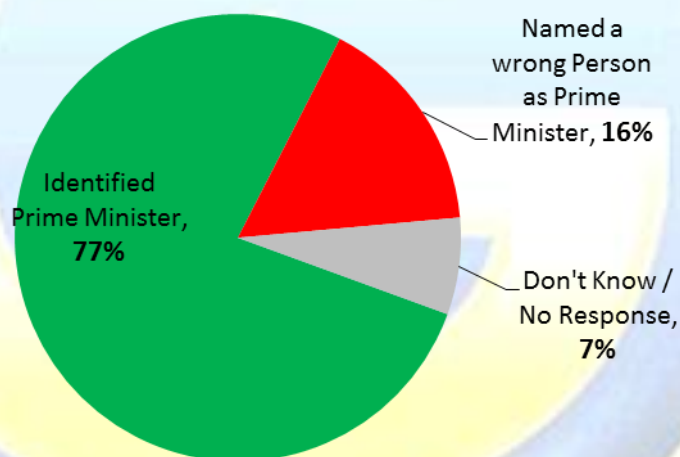
77% could identify the Prime Minister correctly, 16% named a wrong person, 7% were unable to answer the question. GILANI POLL/GALLUP PAKISTAN

Islamabad, April 13, 2012

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 77% could identify the Prime Minister correctly, 16% named a wrong person, 7% were unable to answer the question.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked "Can you tell the name of Pakistan's Prime Minister?" Responding to this 77% correctly identified Prime Minister as Yousaf Raza Gilani whereas 16% named a wrong person. However 7% did not give a view.

The study was released by Gilani foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2586 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during February 26 - March 03, 2012. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

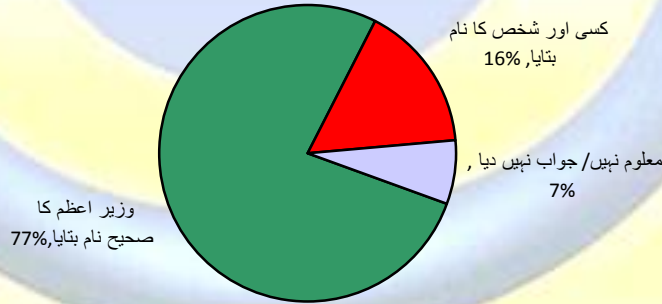

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایک حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 77% پاکستانیوں نے وزیر اعظم کا نام صحیح بتایا، 16% افراد نے کسی اور شخص کا نام بتایا۔ 7% اس سوال کا جواب نہیں دے سکے۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شماریاتی طور پر منتخب خواتین و حضرات سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "کیا آپ پاکستان کے وزیر اعظم کا نام بتا سکتے ہیں؟"، اس سوال کے جواب میں 77% جوابدہندگان نے وزیر اعظم یوسف رضا گیلانی کا نام صحیح بتایا، جبکہ 16% نے غلط نام بتایا۔ 7% نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔
