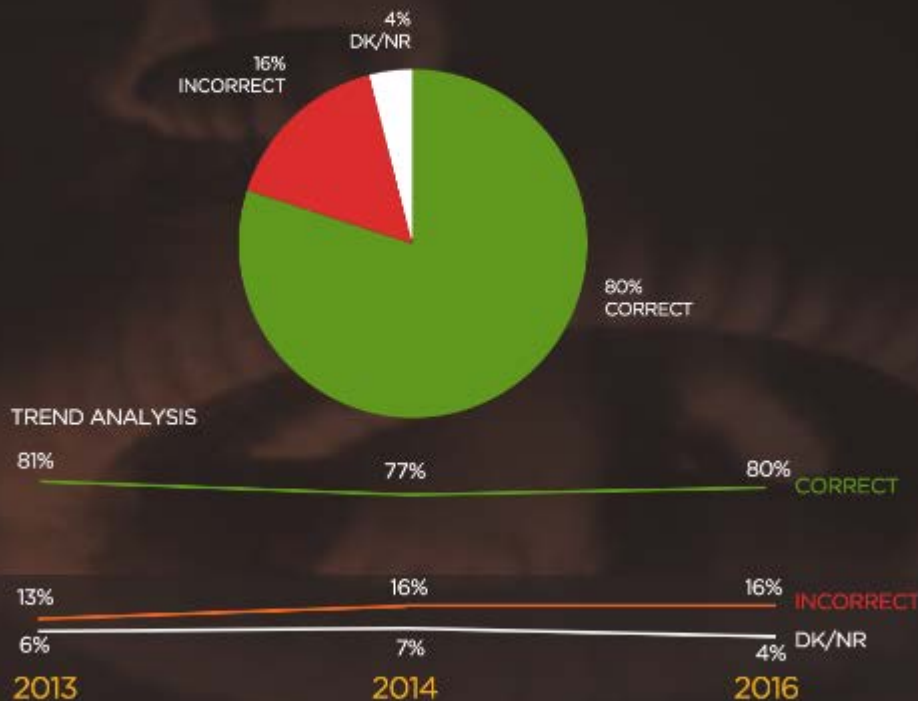


16% ADULT PAKISTANIS FAIL TO NAME MUHAMMAD ALI JINNAH AS THE FOUNDER OF PAKISTAN.

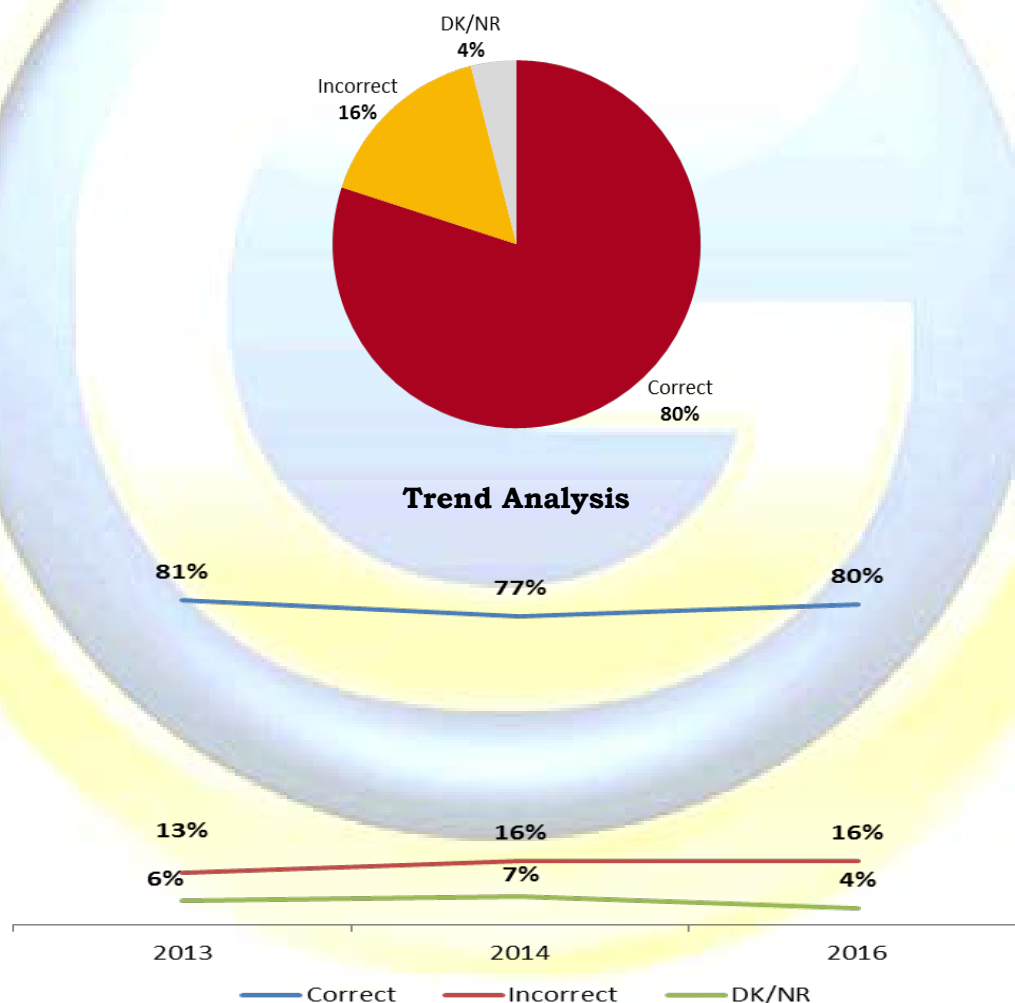

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 80% Pakistanis gave the correct answer when questioned about the name of the founder of Pakistan.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, from across the four provinces was asked, "Please tell us, what is the name of the founder of Pakistan?" In response to this question, 80% respondents gave the correct answer while 16% answered incorrectly and 4% did not respond.

This question was also asked in previous years. 2013, 81% respondents answered correctly and 13% answered incorrectly. In 2014, the figure for correct answers fell down to 77% and that for incorrect answers increased to 16%.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1883 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during January 4 – January 11, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
