Covert Funding of Pakistans' Political Parties (Part 2)

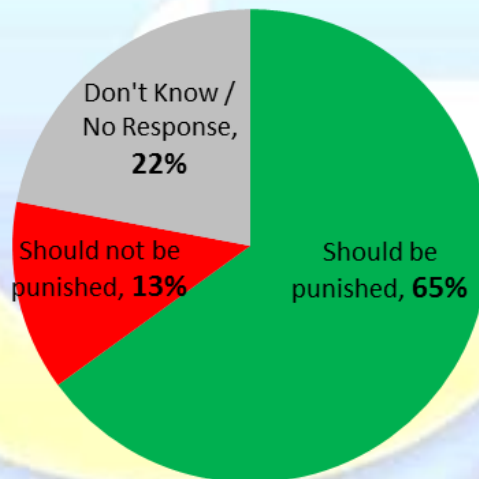
65% favor punishment for politicians and journalists who received covert political funding; 13% oppose, 22% are unsure. GILANI POLL/GALLUP PAKISTAN

Islamabad, March 26, 2012

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan 65% favor punishment for politicians and journalists who received covert political funding; 13% oppose, 22% are unsure.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked "In your opinion, the politicians and the journalists who took money should be punished or not?" Responding to this 65% believe that the politicians and journalists who took money should be punished whereas 13% believe that they should not be punished. However 22% did not give a view.

The study was released by Gilani foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2703 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during March 04 – March 10, 2012. Error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 per cent at 95% confidence level.

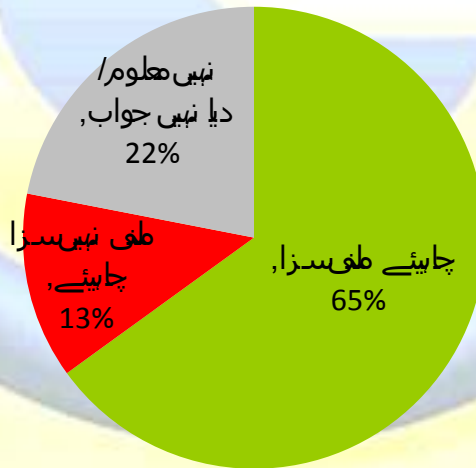

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شماریاتی طور پر منتخب خواتین و حضرات سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "آپ کے خیال میں جن سیاستدانوں اور صحافیوں کو رقم ملی تھی، کیا انہیں اب کسی قسم کی سزا ملنی چاہیے یا نہیں؟" اس سوال کے جواب میں 65% جوابدہندگان نے کہا کہ ان سیاستدانوں اور صحافیوں کو سزا ملنی چاہیے، جبکہ 13% کے خیال میں انہیں سزا نہیں ملنی چاہیے۔ بتایا 22% نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔
