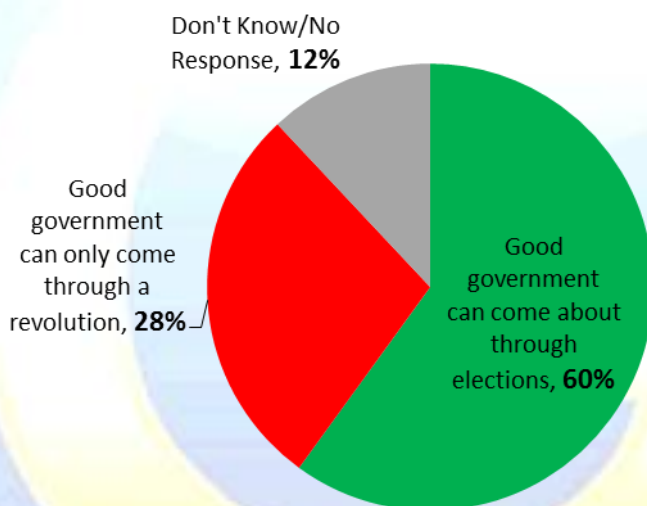
60% of Pakistanis think it is possible for a good government to come through elections. GILANI POLL/GALLUP PAKISTAN

Islamabad, February 04, 2013

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 60% of Pakistanis think it is possible for a good government to come through elections.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “In your opinion, can a good government come through elections or can it only come about through a revolution?” Responding to this, 60% think it is possible for a good government to come through elections and 28% think a good government can only come about through a revolution. However, 12% did not give a response.

The study was released by Gilani foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2644 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during January 13, 2013 – January 20, 2013. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

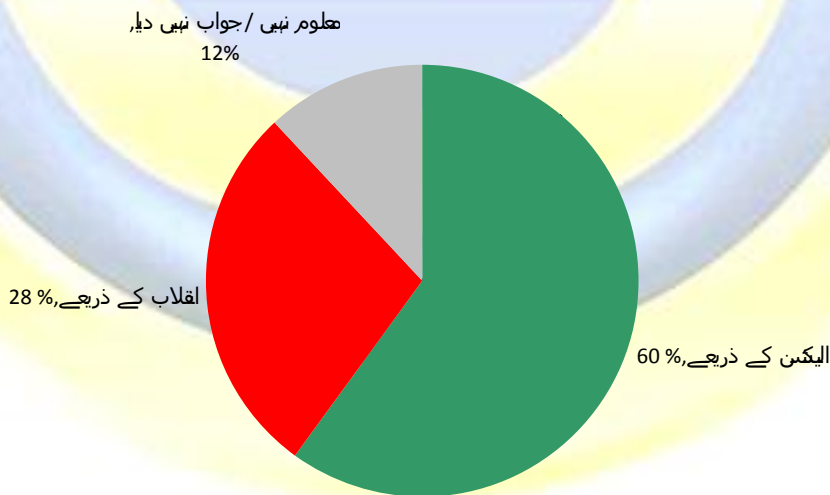

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایک حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 60% پاکستانیوں کے مطابق الیکشن کے ذریعے اچھی حکومت آسکتی ہے۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شاریاتی طور پر منتخب مرد و خواتین سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "آپ کے خیال میں کیا الیکشن کے ذریعے سے اچھی حکومت آسکتی ہے یا پھر انقلاب کے ذریعے سے ہی اچھی حکومت آسکتی ہے؟"، اس سوال کے جواب میں 60% جوابدہندگان کے مطابق الیکشن کے ذریعے اچھی حکومت آسکتی ہے، 28% کے مطابق انقلاب کے ذریعے سے ہی اچھی حکومت آسکتی ہے، تاہم 12% نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔

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گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کا حالیہ سروے گیلپ انٹرنیشنل سے منسلک گیلپ پاکستان کی مدد سے کیا گیا۔ یہ سروے پاکستان کے چاروں صوبوں کی دیہی اور شہری آبادی کے 2644 مرد و خواتین سے 13 جنوری تا 20 جنوری 2013 میں منعقد ہوا۔ غلطی کے امکان کا تخمینہ شاریاتی طور پر تقریباً $\pm 2-3\%$ لگایا گیا ہے۔
