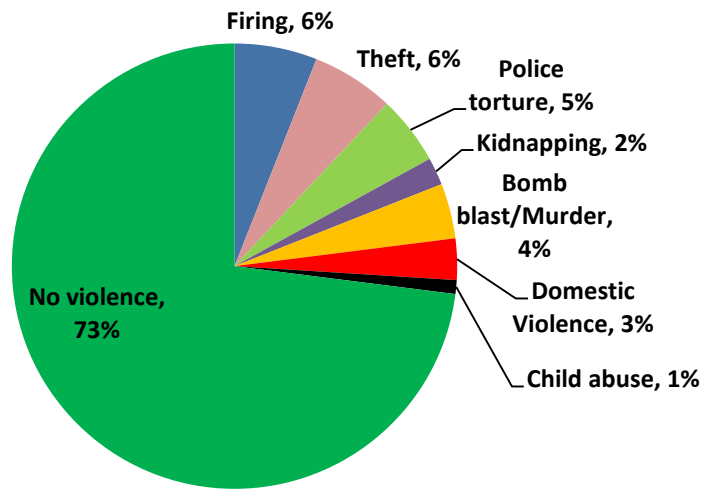

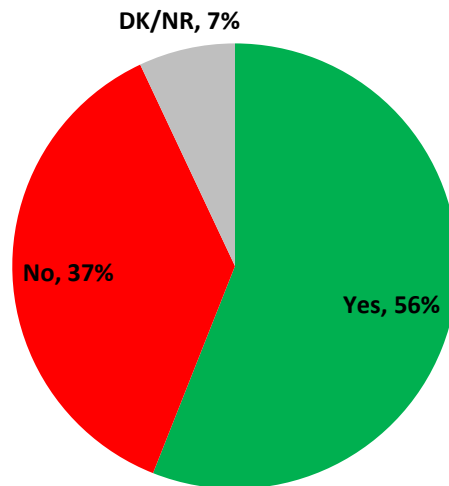

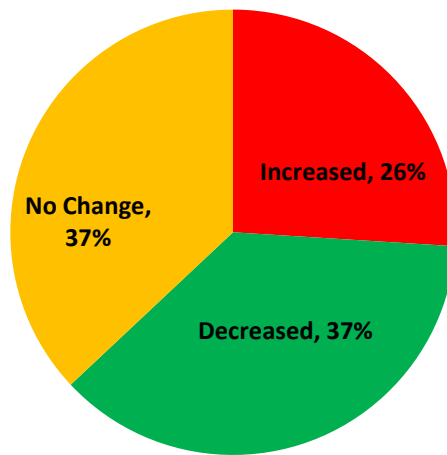

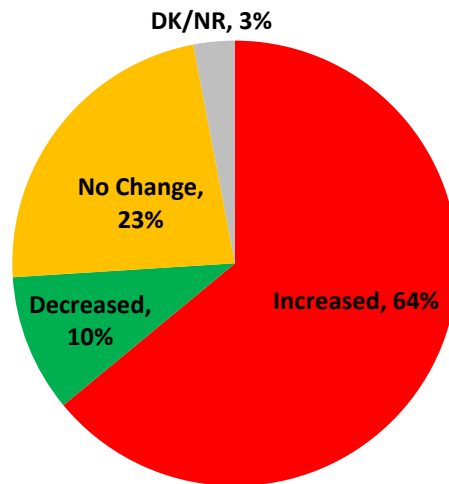
Question: **Has the rate of theft and disorder increased or decreased or remained the same over the last year in your area/ neighborhood?**

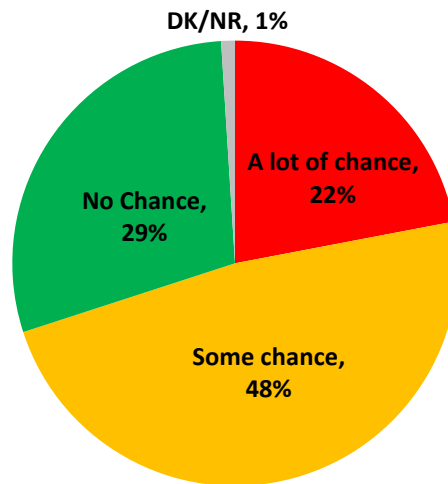

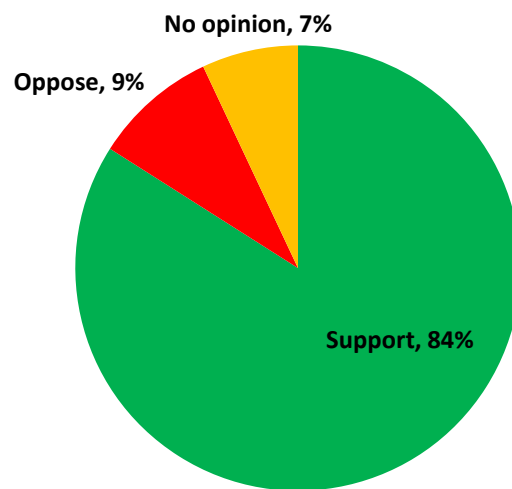

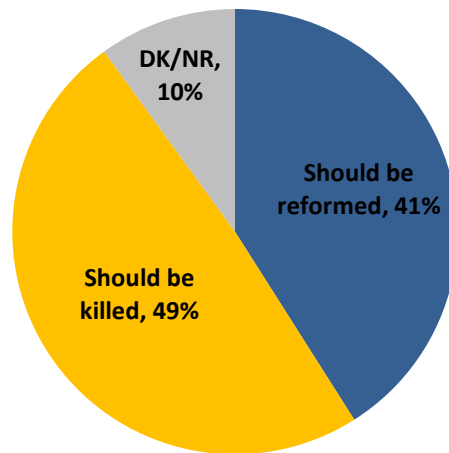

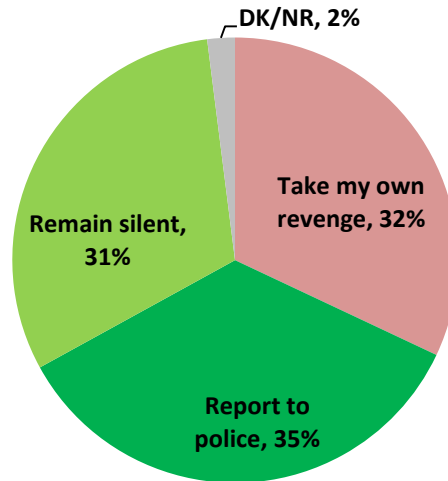

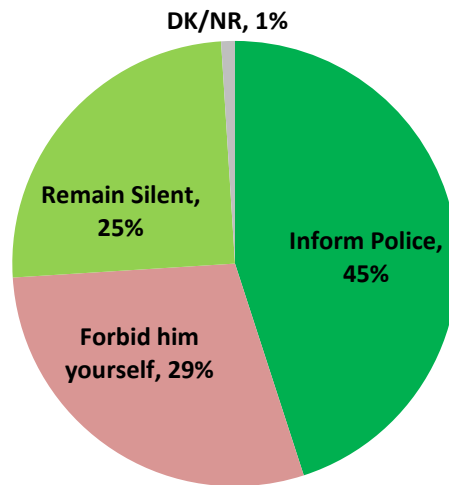

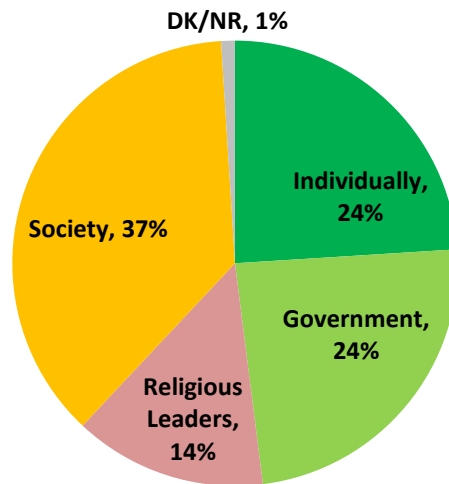

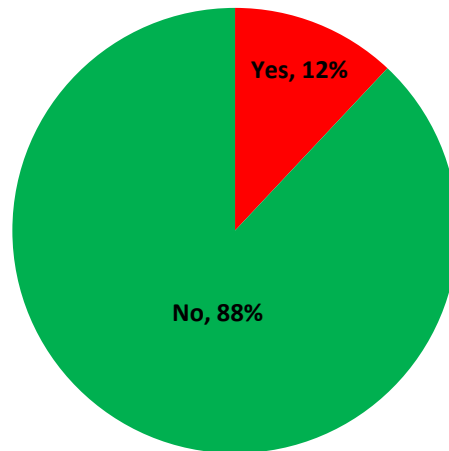

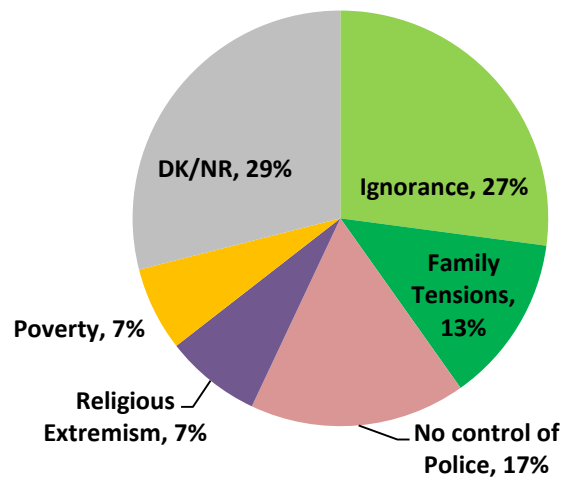

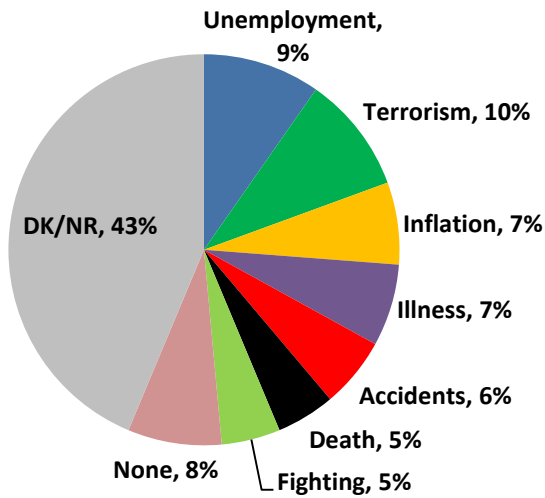

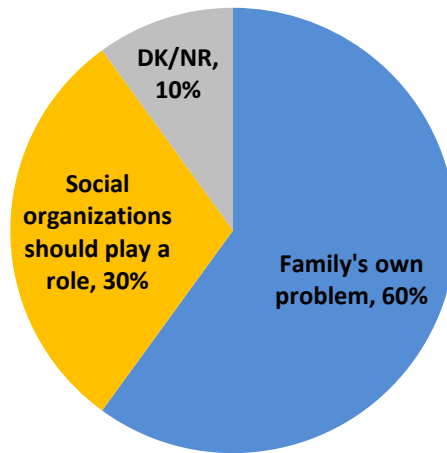

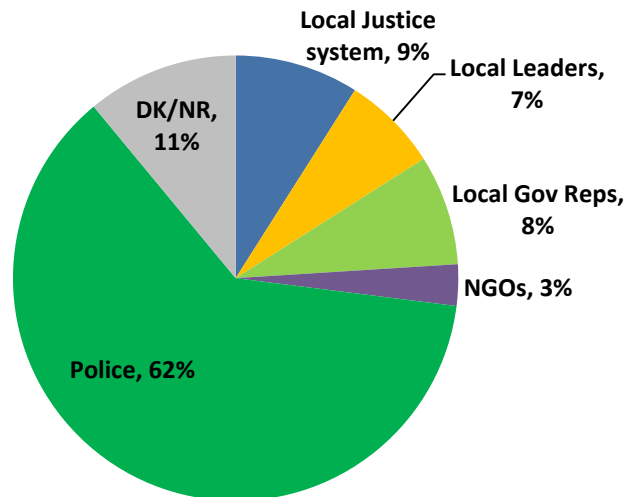

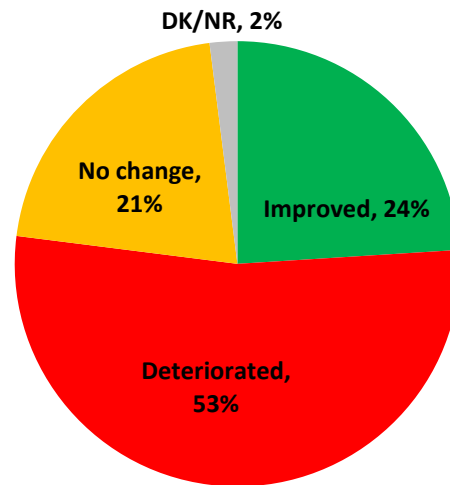

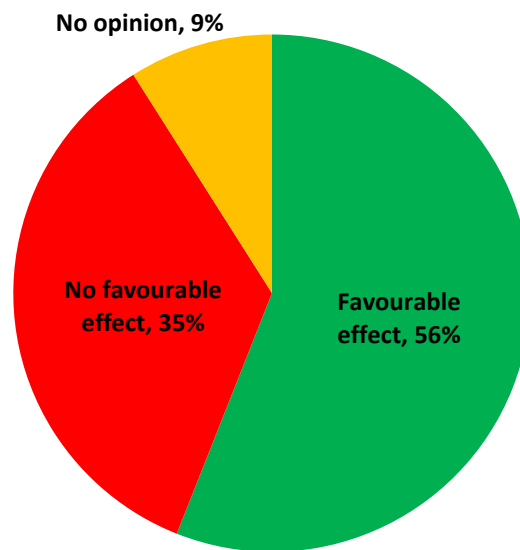

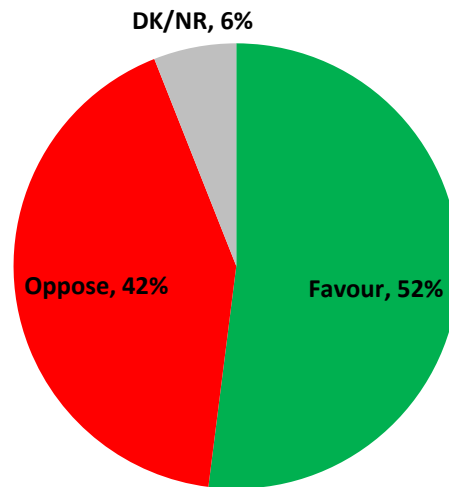

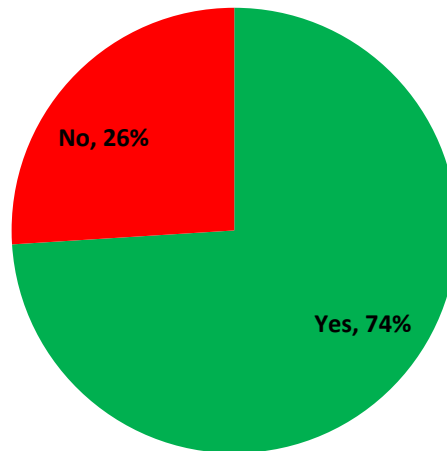

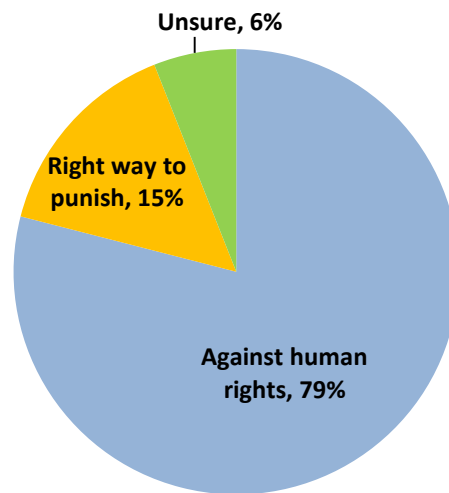

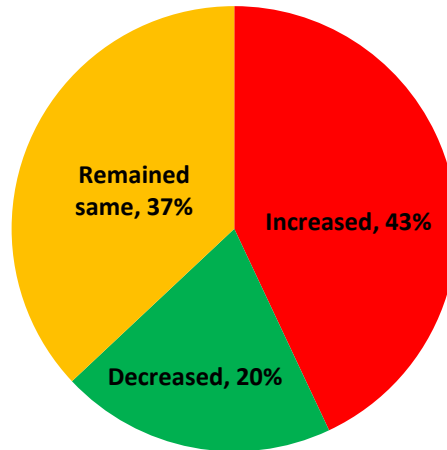

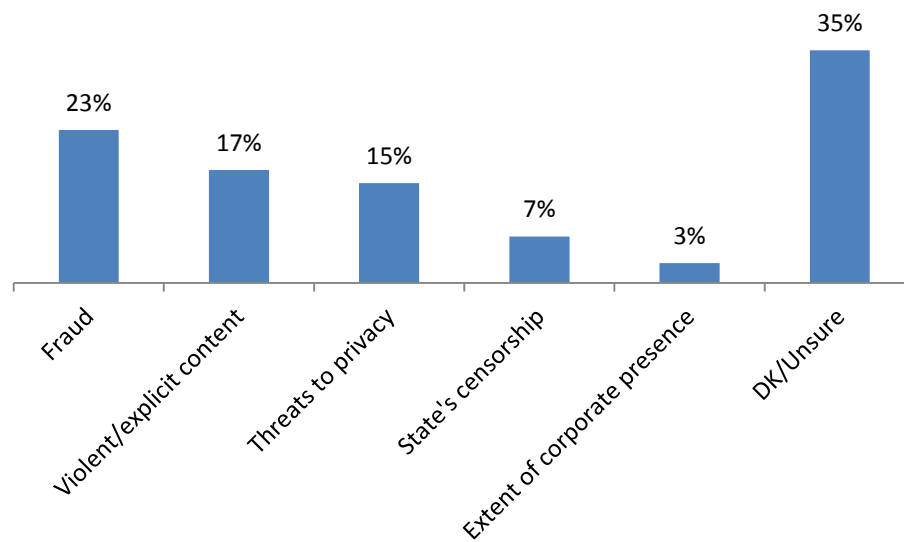

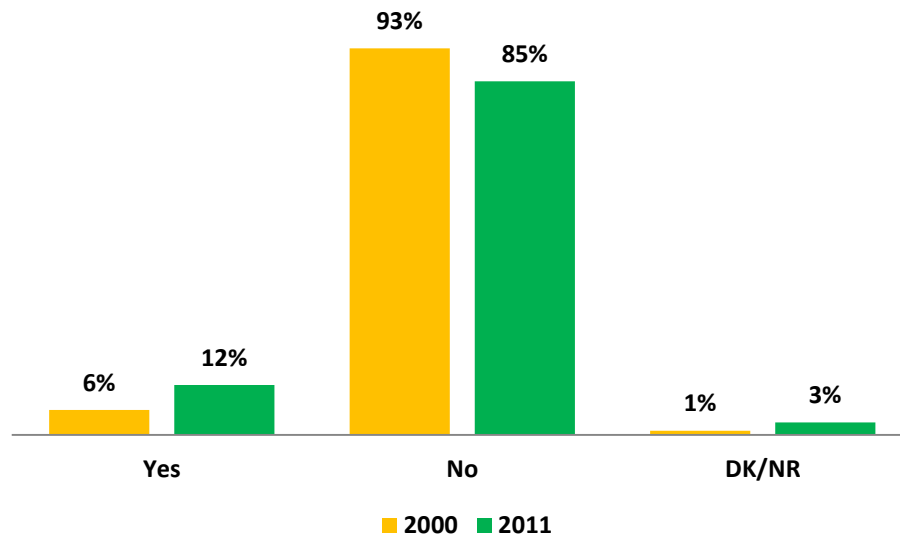

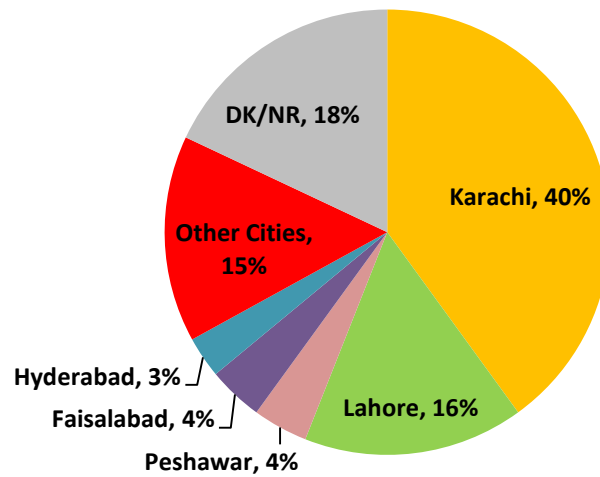

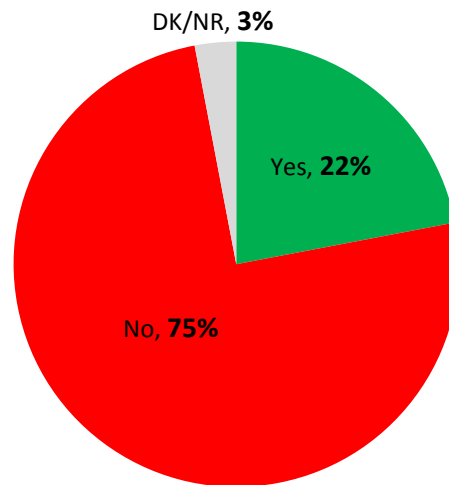

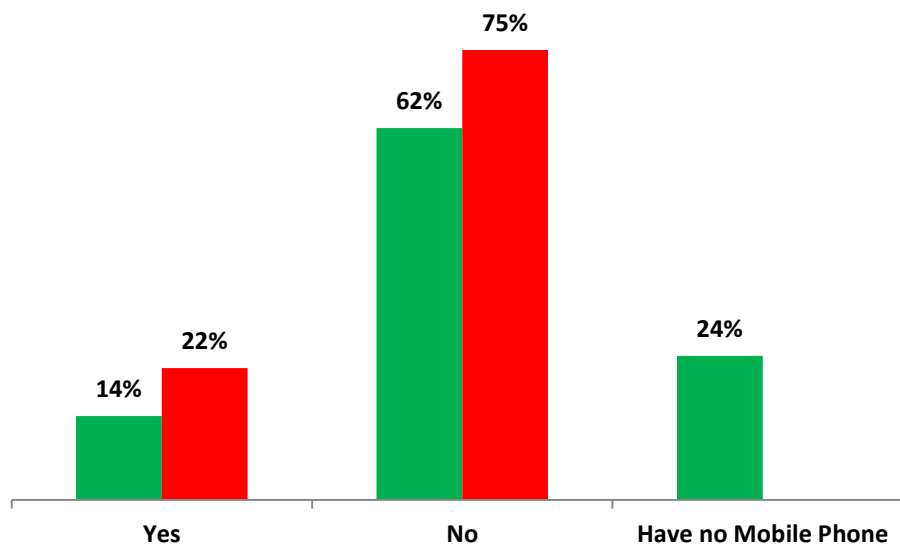

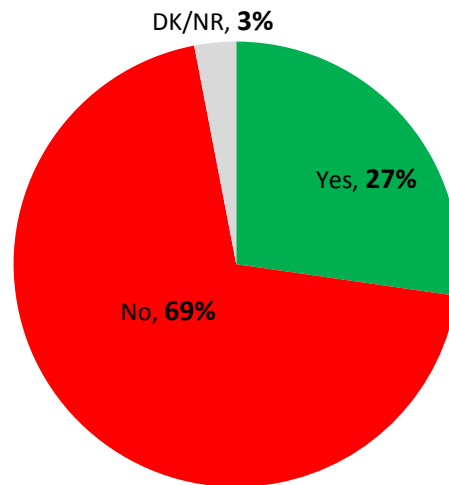

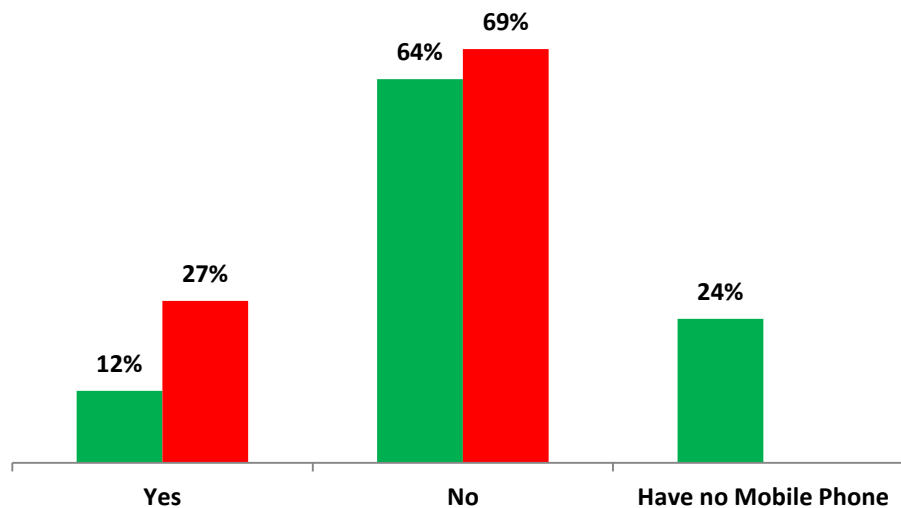

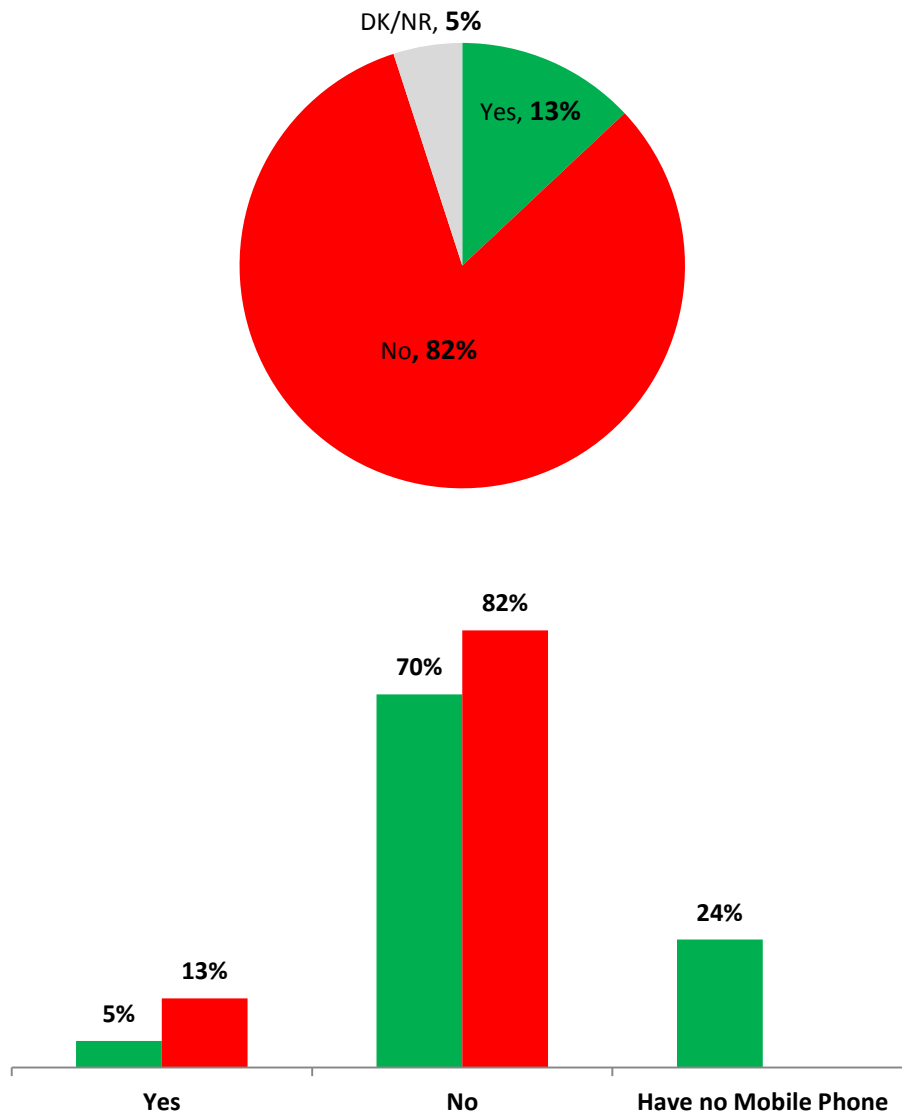

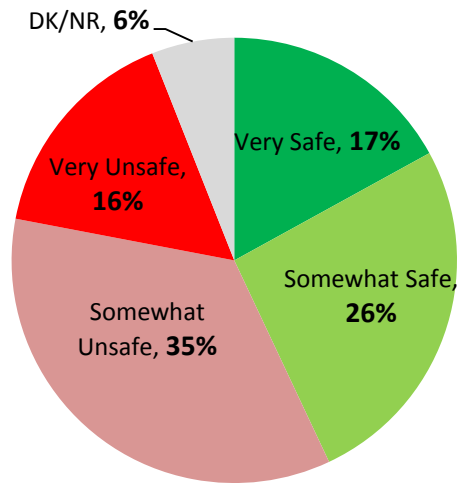

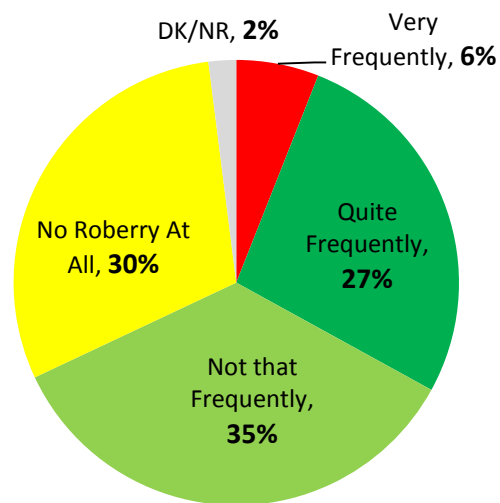

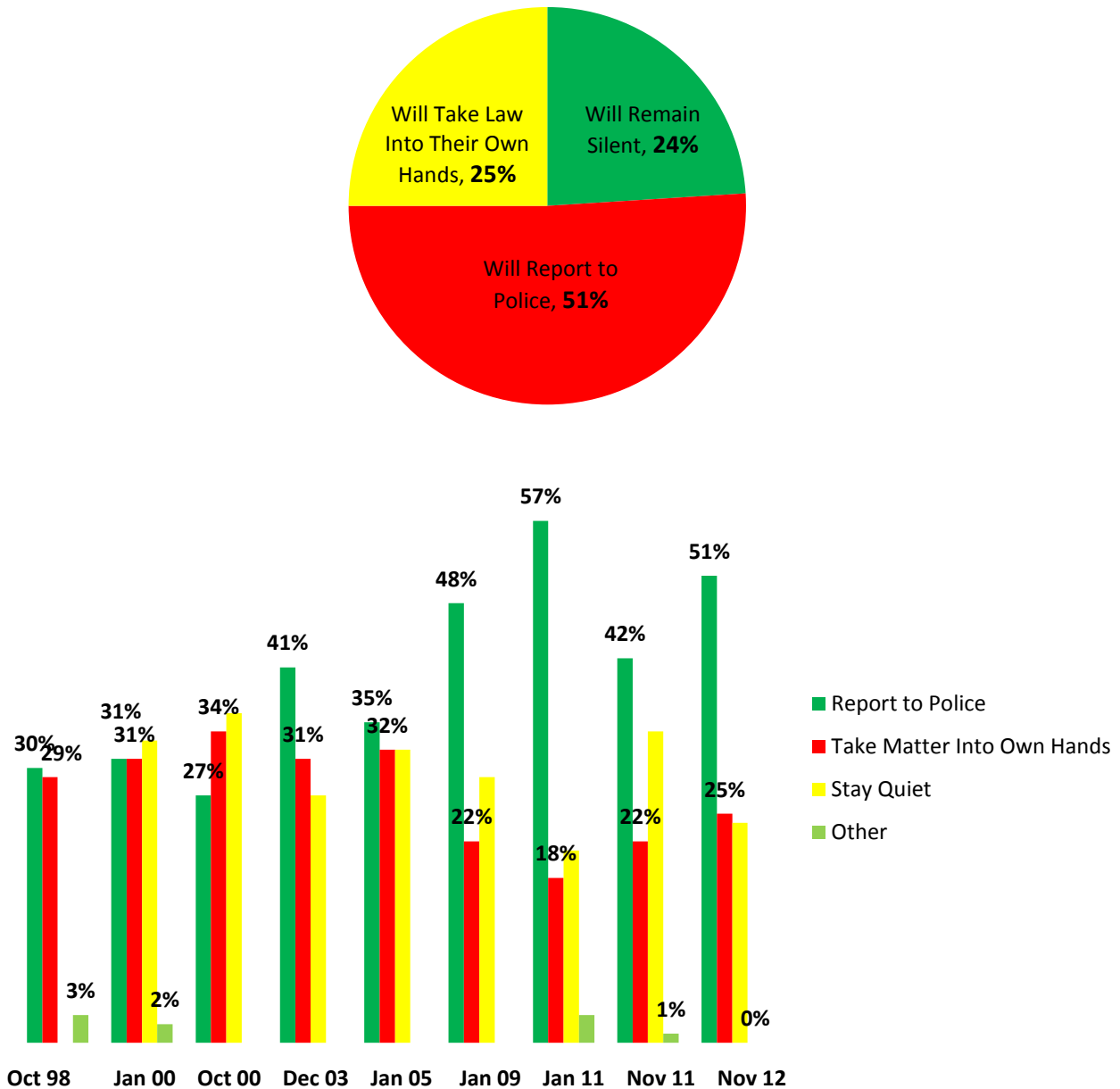

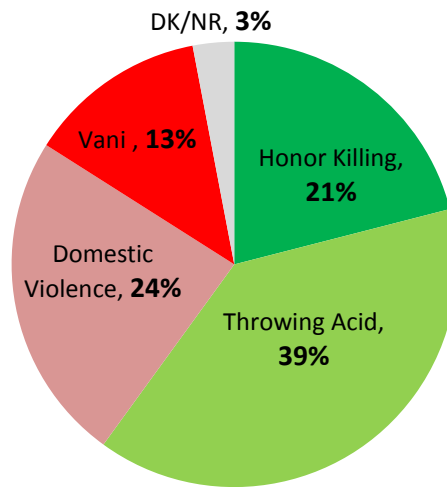

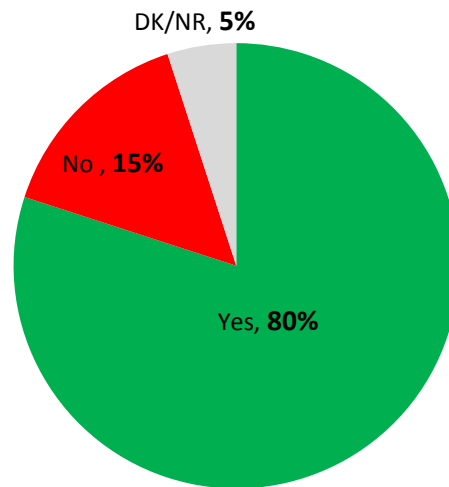

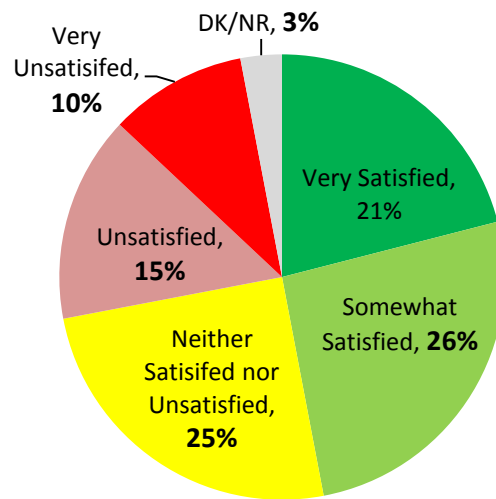

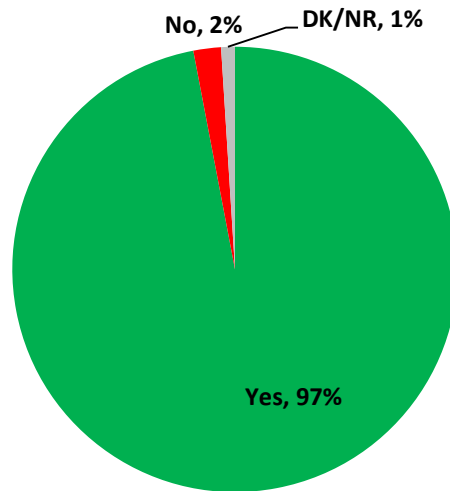

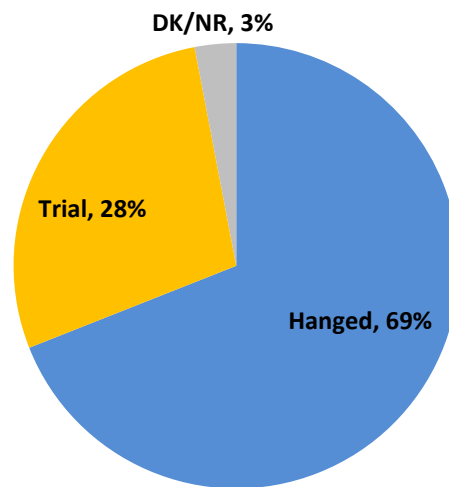

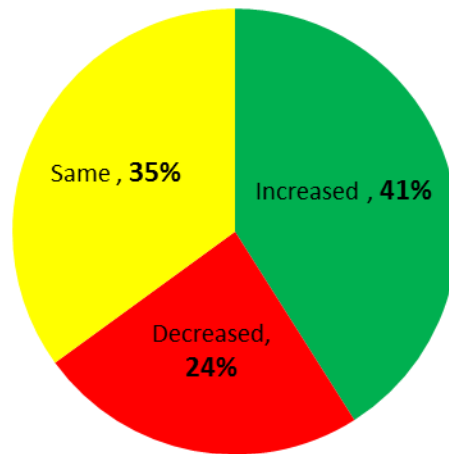

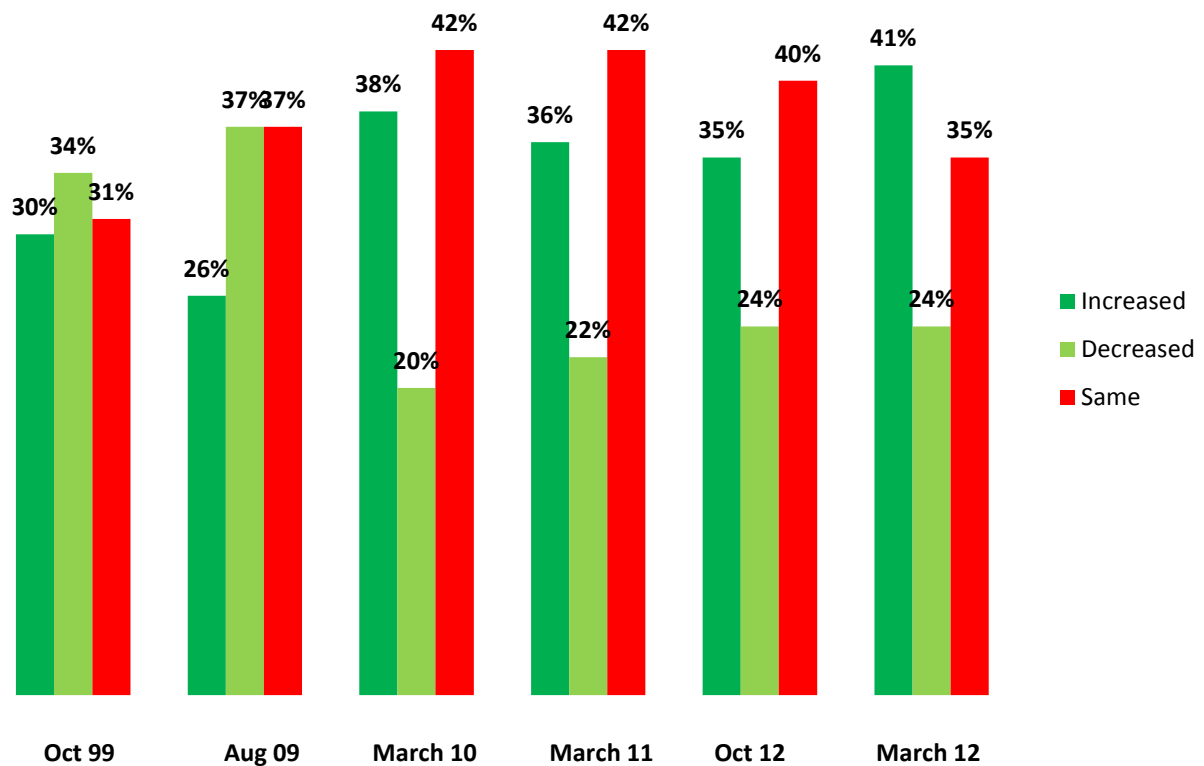

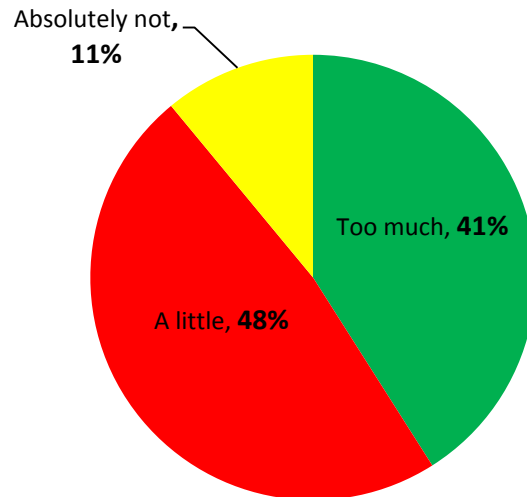

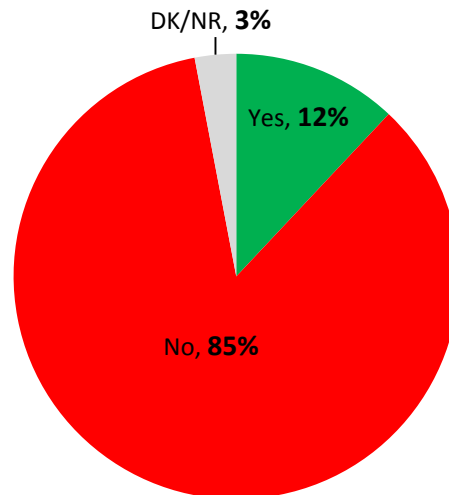

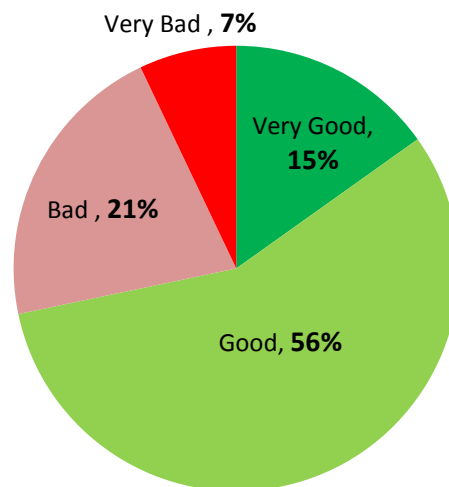

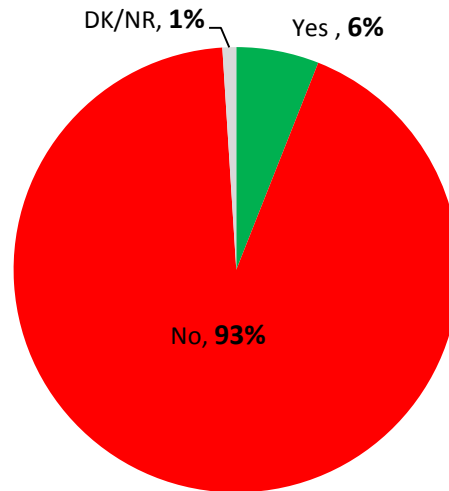

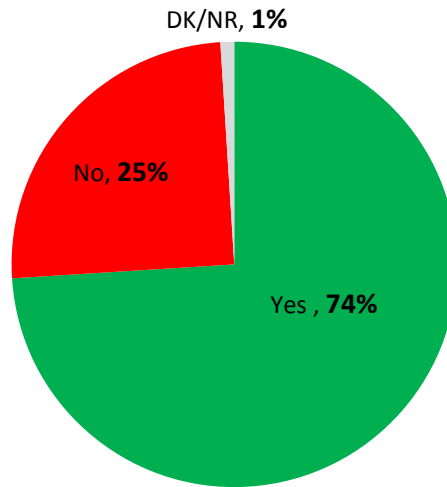

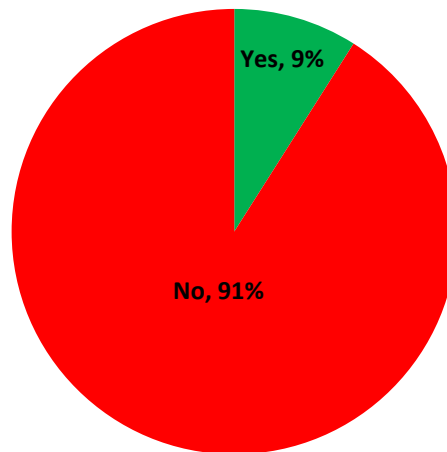

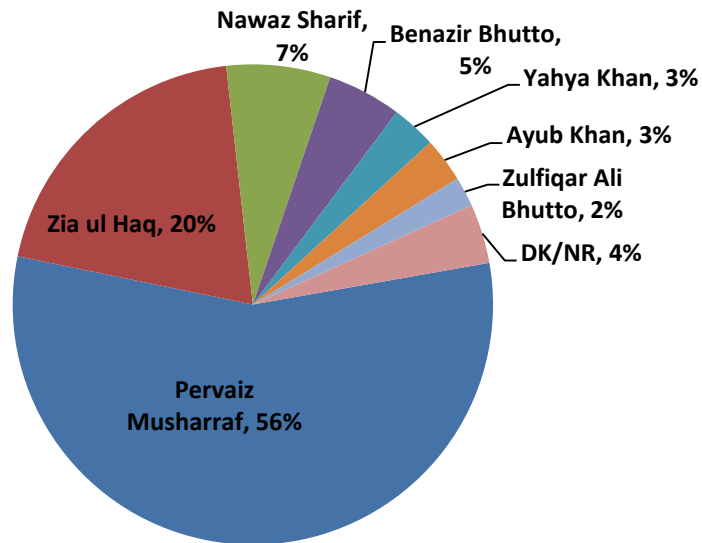

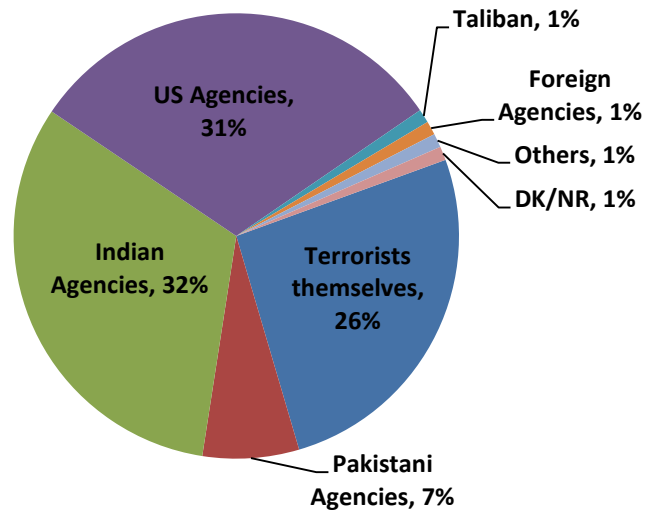

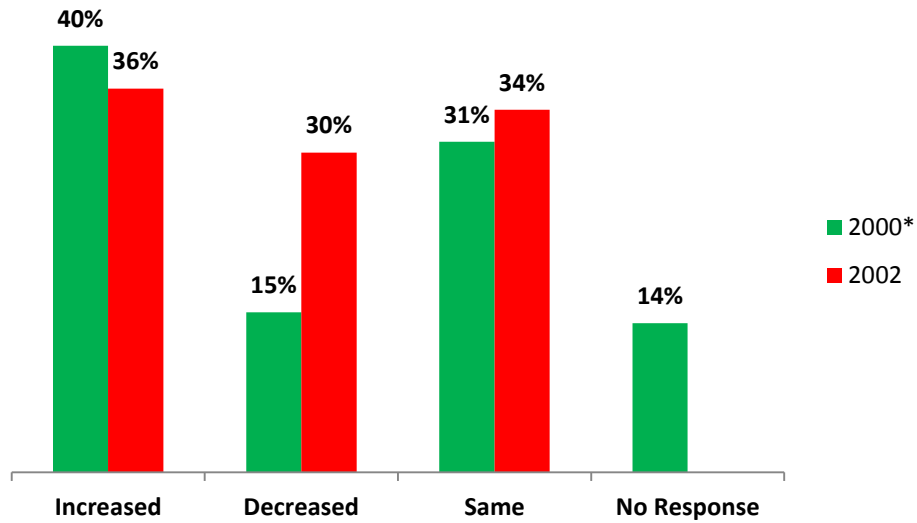

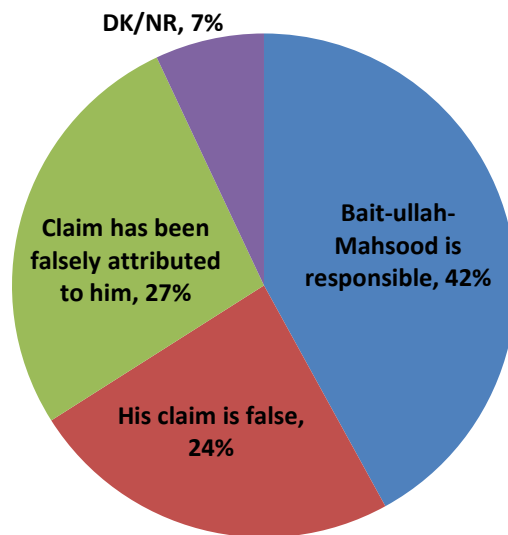

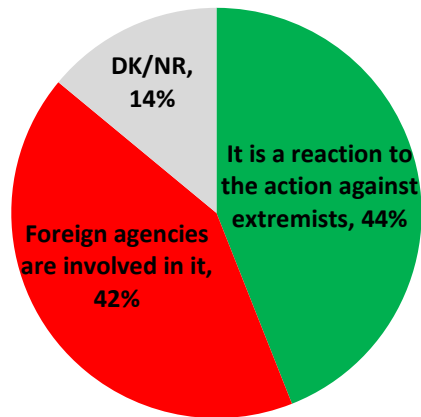

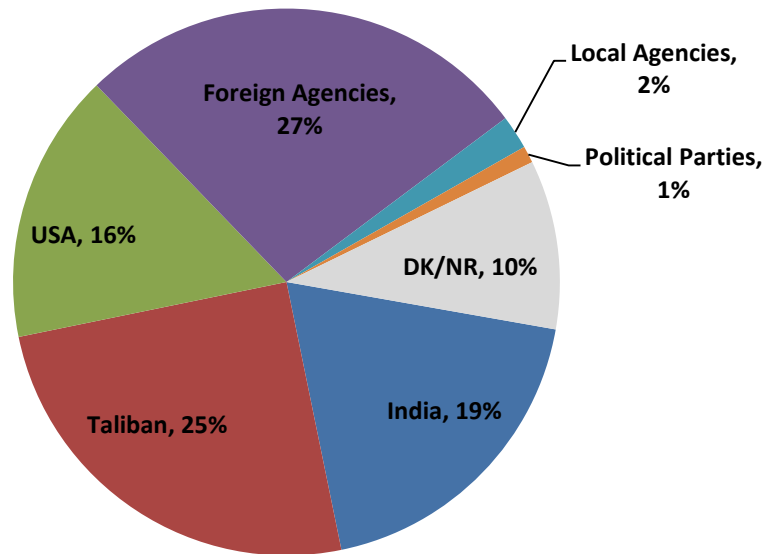

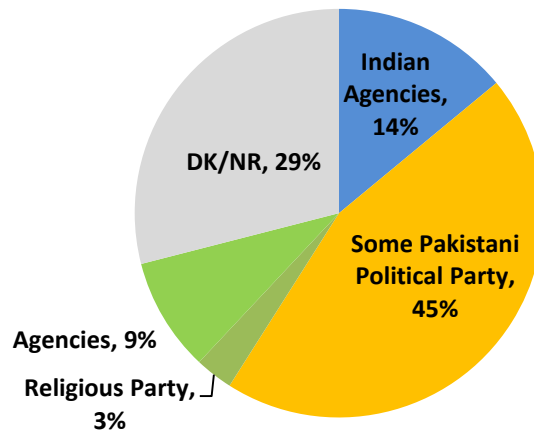

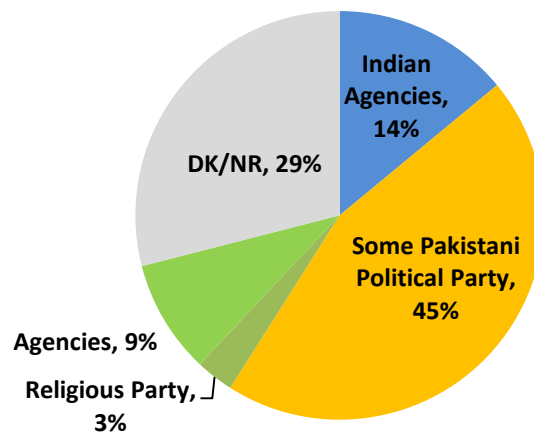

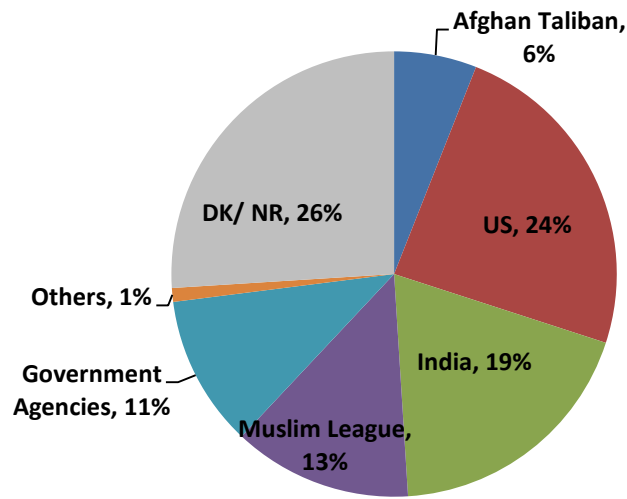

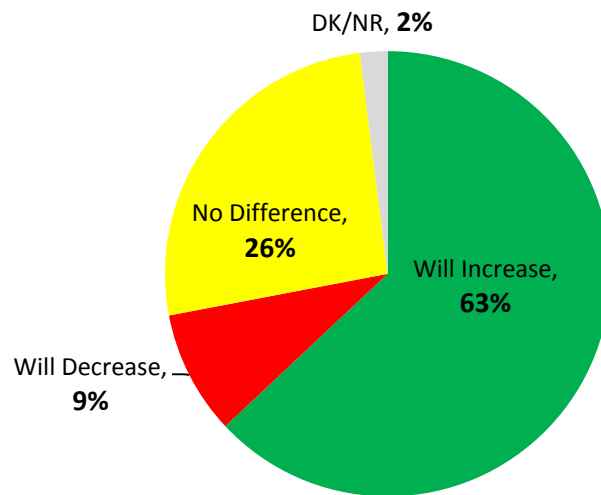

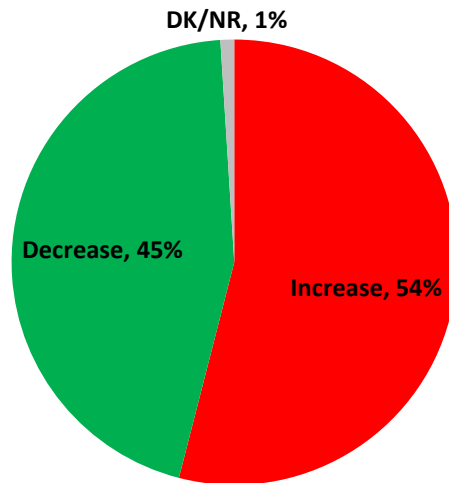

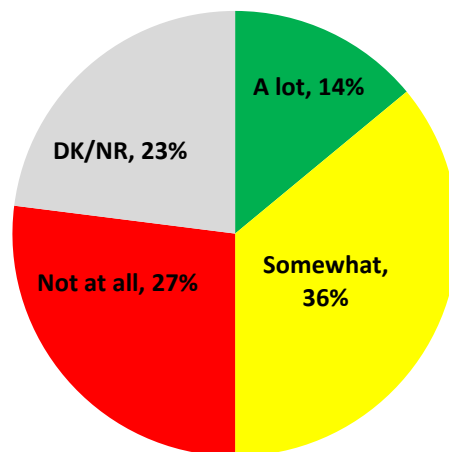

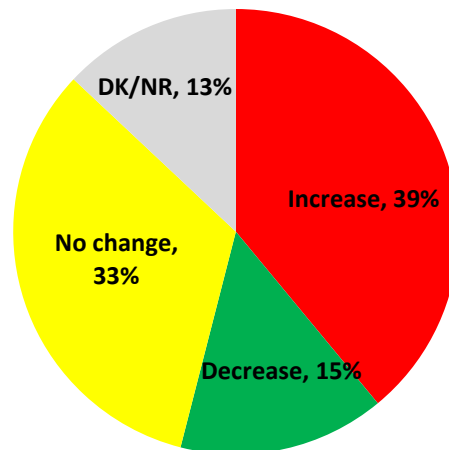
