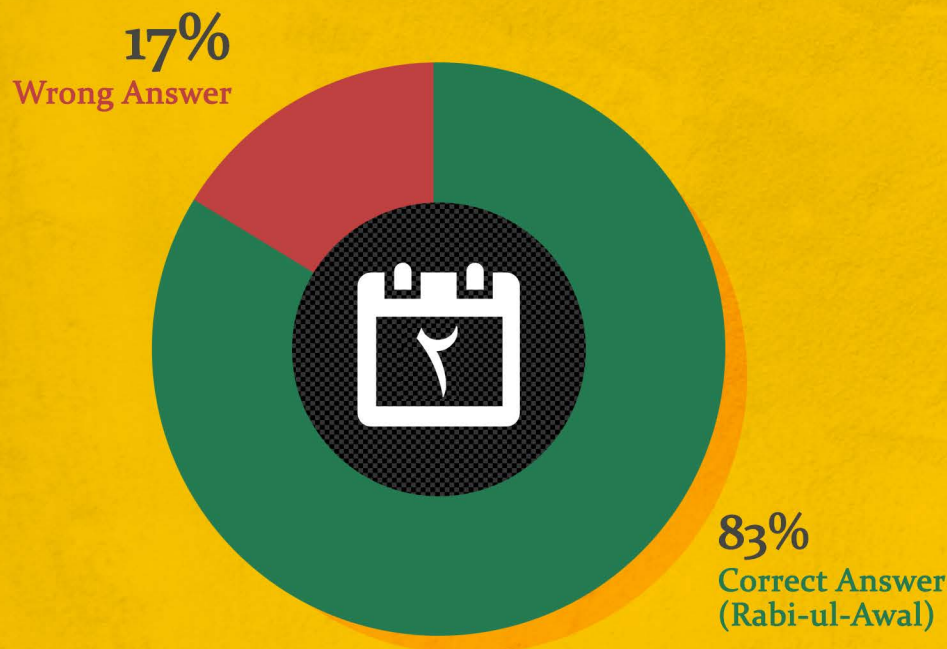


Do you know the Islamic month these days?

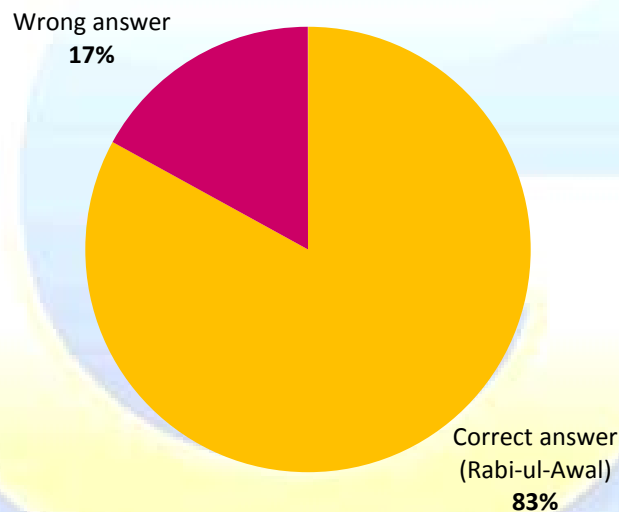

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 83% Pakistanis answered correctly when they were asked about the name of the ongoing Islamic month (Rabi-ul-Awal).

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Do you know the Islamic month these days?” In response to this question, 83% correctly answered it to be Rabi-ul-Awal while 17% gave an incorrect answer.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1849 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during January 11 – January 18, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
