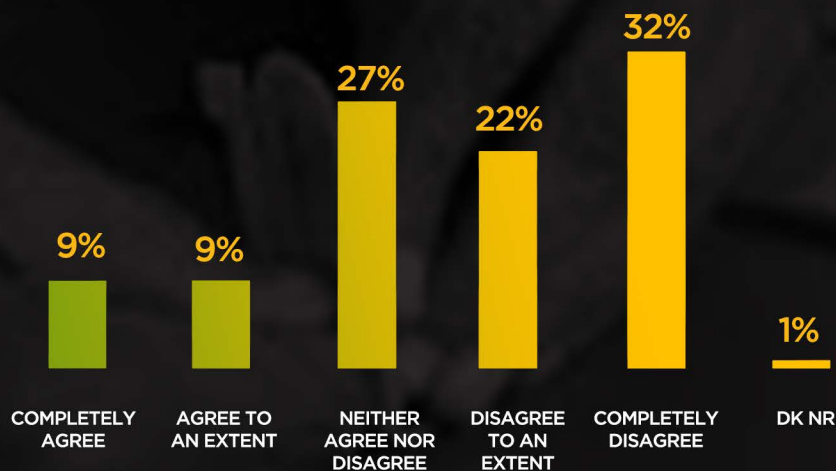

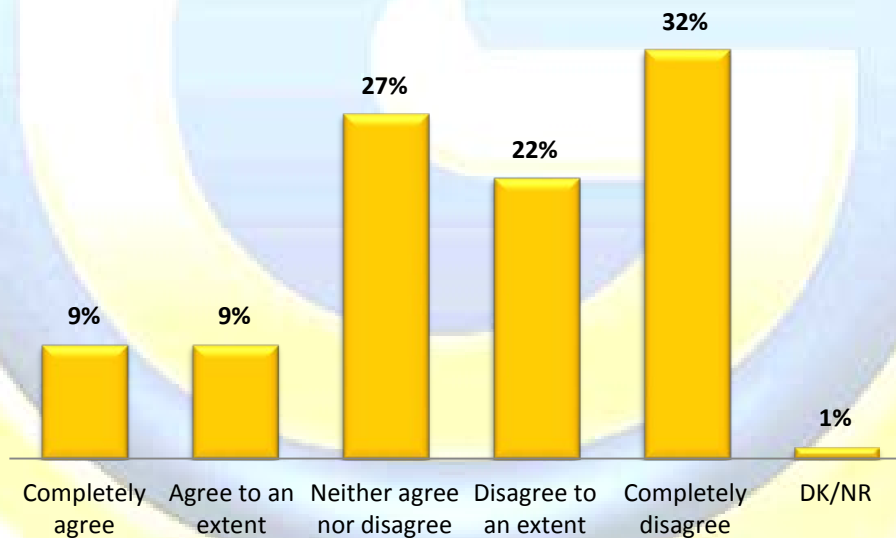
Majority Pakistanis (54 %) feel that the Government should not retain its employees if it does not need them. GILANI RESEARCH FOUNDATION (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, May 23, 2016

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 54% Pakistanis disagreed with the statement; ‘the government should keep its employees even if it does not need them’.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Please tell, to what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement: ‘the government should keep its employees even if it does not need them?’” In response to this question, 9% agreed completely, 9% agreed to an extent while 27% neither agreed nor disagreed. On the other hand, 22% Pakistanis disagreed to an extent and 32% completely disagreed with the statement. 1% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1783 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during February 15 – February 22, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
