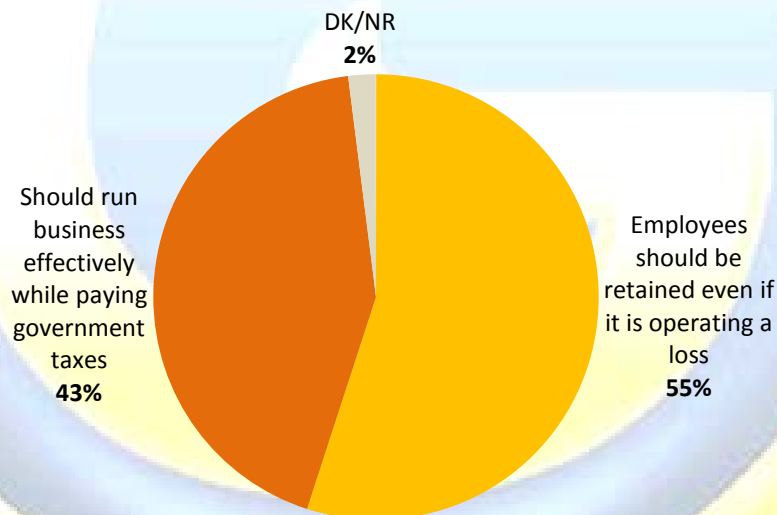

Islamabad, May 24, 2016

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 55% Pakistanis stated that it is the responsibility of the Pakistan International Airlines (PIA) to retain its employees even if it is operating at a loss.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Please tell, do you think it is the PIA’s responsibility to retain its employees even if it is operating at a loss or should the PIA be running its business effectively while paying government taxes?” In response to this question, 55% Pakistanis said that employees should be retained even if PIA goes in a loss while 43% said that PIA should run its business effectively and pay government taxes.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1783 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during February 15 – February 22, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
