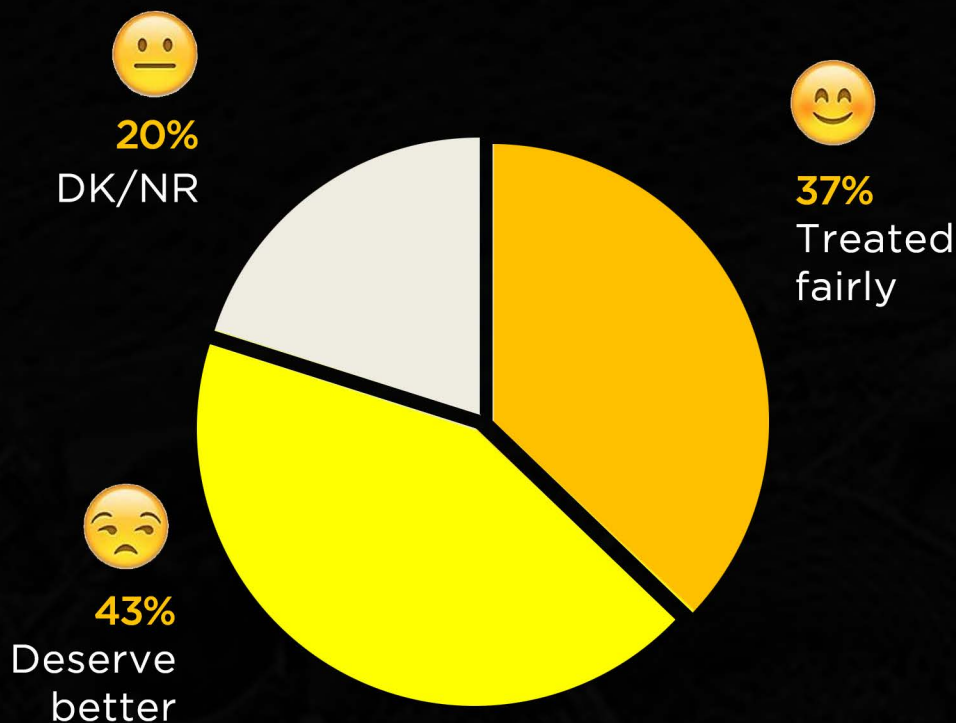


43% PAKISTANIS FEEL THAT THEY DESERVE TO BE TREATED BETTER IN LIFE.

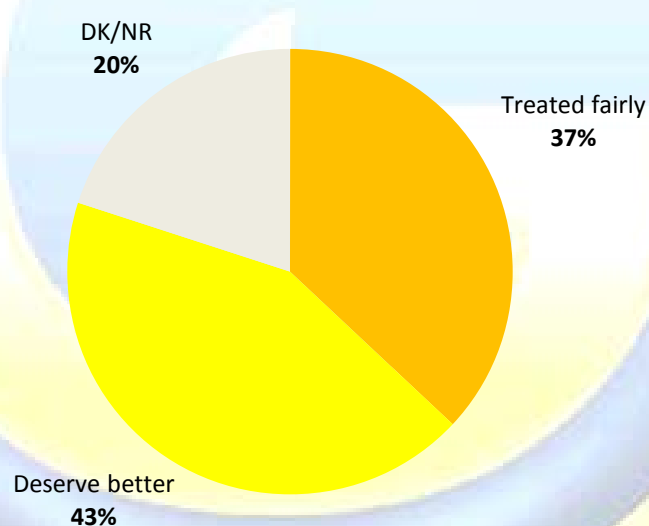
43 % Pakistanis feel that they deserve to be treated better in life.

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 43% Pakistanis, when asked if they thought they were being treated fairly in life or whether they deserved better treatment, said that they deserved to be treated better.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Do you think you are treated fairly in life or do you deserve better?” In response to this question, 37% Pakistanis said that are being treated fairly while 43% said that they deserve to be treated better. 20% Pakistanis, on the other hand, said that they don’t know.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1832 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during March 14 – March 21, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
