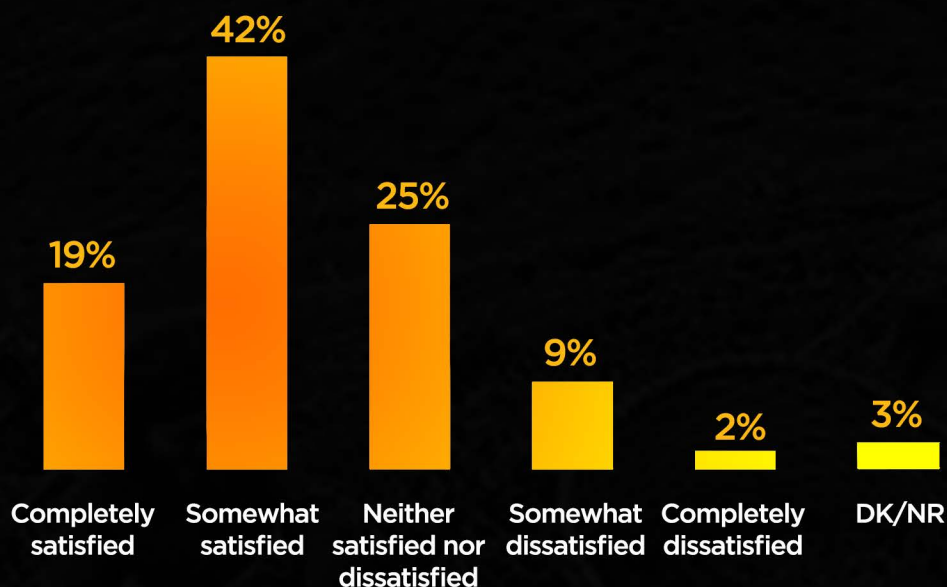


1 IN 3 (36%) PAKISTANIS ARE

Opinion Poll Social Personal Satisfaction

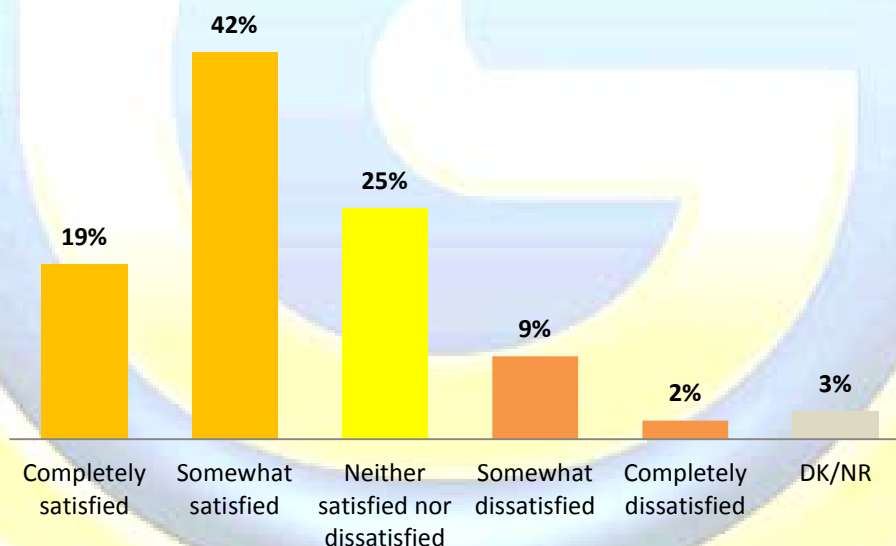
1 in 3 (36%) Pakistanis are dissatisfied or ambivalent towards their neighbours. GILANI RESEARCH FOUNDATION (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, May 31, 2016

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 61% Pakistanis have stated that they are satisfied with their neighbors.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Please tell us the extent to which you are satisfied or dissatisfied with respect to the following things: Your Neighbors?” In response to this question, 19% Pakistanis expressed complete satisfaction with their neighbors, 42% said that they were somewhat satisfied with their neighbors, 25% said that they were neither satisfied nor dissatisfied, 9% said that they were somewhat dissatisfied while 2% expressed a complete dissatisfaction with their neighbors. 3% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1832 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during March 14 – March 21, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
