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According to recent survey conducted by Gallup Pakistan 69% of adults in the urban areas say they have been tested for blood pressure at one or another occasion in their life. The figure is substantially higher for women than men as 81% of women and 57% of men said they had been tested for blood pressure.

The survey was conducted by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International among more than 1000 statistically selected households in the urban area of all the four provinces of Pakistan.
