VISIT OF INDIAN CRICKET TEAM ENJOYS HIGH PUBLIC OPINION

SUPPORT: 88% Favour, 9% Oppose, 3% Give no response

*According to a recent poll by Gallup Pakistan 88% Pakistanis favoured visit of Indian cricket team to Pakistan and 9% opposed it while 3% gave no response. The survey posed a question “**In your opinion should Indian Cricket Team visit Pakistan or not?**”*

The survey was carried out among a national sample of men and women from all the four provinces of the country comprising a cross section of people belonging to various age, income and education groups. More details on the survey are available at www.gallup.com.pk
