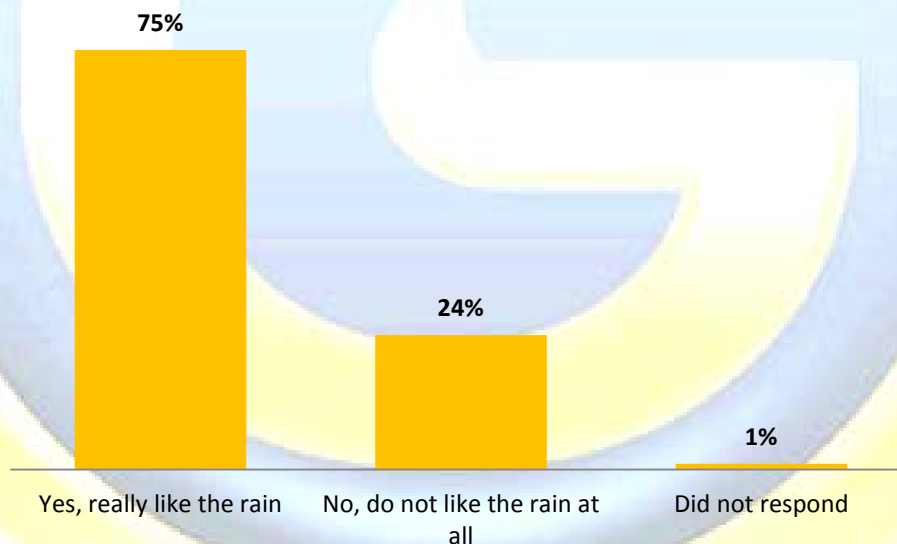
**Upcoming Monsoon Season: Significant majority of Pakistanis (75 %) really like rain and rainy weather. GILANI RESEARCH FOUNDATION (GRF POLL)**

Islamabad, June 15, 2016

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 75% Pakistanis said that they really like rain and rainy weather in general.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Some people like rainy weather whereas others don’t like it at all. Kindly tell us whether you like rain or not?” In response to this question, 75% said that they really like rain, 24% said that they do not like rain at all while 1% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1825 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during April 11 – April 18, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  per cent at 95% confidence level.
