GALLUP PAKISTAN POLL FINDINGS ON

Domestic Help

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TWELVE PERCENT (12%) HOMES EMPLOY DOMESTIC HELP - September 17, 1999

According to a recent study conducted by Gallup Pakistan, 12% of urban homes employ domestic help: 3% have full time servants while 9% have part time servants. The survey was carried out among more than 1000 statistically selected households belonging to a cross section of various income backgrounds spread in the urban areas of all the four provinces of the country.

The survey further reveals that among households whose monthly income is around Rupees twenty thousand, nearly half employ a part time (18%) or full time (29%) servant at home. This weekly Report can also be seen on the internet at www.gallup.com.pk
