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GALLUP PAKISTAN POLL FINDINGS ON

**ECONOMIC ISSUES AS THE FIRST WORRY FOR MAJORITY
PAKISTANIS**

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According to a survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan the first worry for most Pakistanis is economic. So far worries about family matters is a distant second. And few worry about the safety of their life and property. In response to a survey question: "What is the most important issue in your personal life these days?" 67% said "Economic worries", 13% said "Family related worries" and only 7% said the "safety of life and property". The remaining 13% gave miscellaneous answers or could not give a specific response.

The survey was conducted among a nationally representative sample of approximately 1500 men and women belonging to the urban and rural areas of all the four provinces and comprised a cross section of various, income, education, age and geographic segments.
