ONLY 16% OF PAKISTANIS BELIEVE WEALTH COMES FROM HARD WORK: Gallup Survey

36% of Pakistanis believe that those who are wealthy were born with a silver spoon in their mouth, another 28% were of the view that they have amassed wealth through unfair means. Other explanations offered in a national public opinion survey were: The rich minted money from overseas jobs (12%), they were lucky (15%) and they worked hard (16%). Only 6% believed that the rich acquired their wealth by virtue of good education.

The survey was carried out among a national sample of men and women from all the four provinces of the country comprising a cross section of people belonging to various age, income and education groups. More details on the survey are available at www.gallup.com.pk
