HUSBAND–WIFE CONFIRMITY ON RELIGION, MORALITY, POLITICS

Married couples as they slowly progress past thirties, forties and fifties to mellowed sixties, tend to cultivate a married harmony and community of views between themselves on matters such as politics, religion and morality, a Gallup poll recently held indicated.

The survey was conducted with a cross section of ages of population belonging to various age and education groups in all the four provinces of Pakistan.

Apart from comparative youth, the educated tend to make their spouses independent in their thinking.

The survey finding reveals that the spouses tend to agree much more on religious and moral issues than on social and especially political matters. Thus while only 3% of husbands say that they do not share their views on religion, 9% say the same about social issues and 18% admit of a difference of opinion with their wives on matter on politics.

The query put to husbands only was: do you, or do you not, hold similar views with your wife on the following subjects:
