DRUGS ARE A SERIOUS PROBLEM

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70% BELIEVE DRUGS ARE A SERIOUS PROBLEM

According to a recent Gallup poll slightly 70% Pakistanis believe that the use of drugs, such as heroin and opium, is a very serious problem among their fellow citizens. Another 22% regard it as quite a serious problem, while 5% think that the use of drugs among Pakistanis does not pose a serious problem. 2% did not answer this question. These findings have emerged from a nation-wide survey conducted by Gallup Pakistan in more than 200 statistically selected villages and towns all over the country. The findings of the survey were computer processed.
