GALLUP PAKISTAN POLL FINDINGS ON

RATING ON ISLAMIZATION

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Saudi Arabia, Iran, and Pakistan Rate High on Islamization

Several countries, including Pakistan, Iran and Saudi Arabia had set out to introduce the “Islamic System”; which one, or ones, of these have succeeded better than other, was the subject of a nationwide survey held recently in the four provinces of Pakistan, Punjab, Sindh, NWFP and Baluchistan. The respondents belonged to various age and education groups.

According to the Gallup Pakistan Sample Survey, Saudi Arabia wins the top position (8 marks out of 10) with Iran and Pakistan following (each scoring 6 marks out of 10). Egypt lags behind the others with 3 marks out of 10.

Question: Several countries of the world have been trying to introduce the Islamic System, in their own various ways and styles. Some have apparently been striving harder with greater measure of success than others. If you are asked to award 10 marks out of 10 to a country for excellent or very good effort, and “0” to another with poor or very bad effort; where on the measurement scale, 0 to 10, would you place the following:
