MAJORITY BELIEVES INDIA HAS NUCLEAR WEAPONS

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MAJORITY BELIEVES INDIA HAS NUCLEAR WEAPONS

According to the latest Gallup poll, a majority of Pakistanis believe that India possesses nuclear weapon. A nation-wide survey posed the question: “According to your information, how likely is it that India has already acquired nuclear weapons: very likely, somewhat likely, not very likely, not likely at all?” 63% of the respondents said they believed it was very likely that India had nuclear weapons. 16% said it was somewhat likely while only 9% said there was little or no likelihood of India’s possessing nuclear weapons. 12% did not answer this question.

The survey was conducted with a scientific sample of the population in 200 villages and urban localities all over the country.
