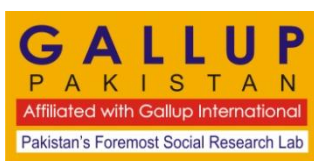

3 KEY FINDINGS

Gallup Pakistan Survey shows mixed opinions on who is to blame and how to handle the Panama Leaks Issue



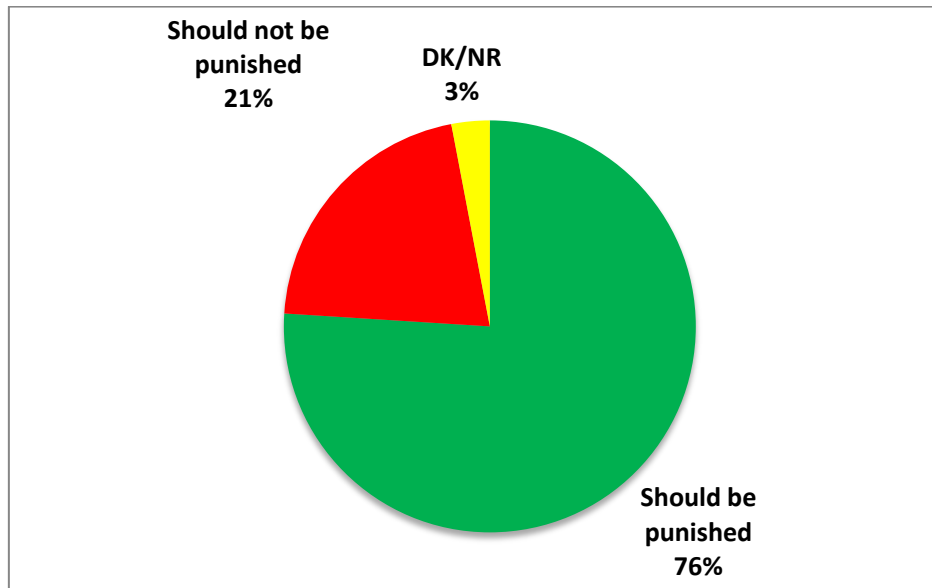

Key Finding # 1:

76% support Punishment for those guilty on the issue of off-shore companies

Question: Some people are of the opinion that as it is legal to form off shore companies in some foreign countries, the owner should not be punished. While some are of the opinion that whether offshore companies are legal or illegal, their owners should be punished as forming offshore companies in foreign countries is wrong. What is your opinion?

Methodology: Sample Size: 1707; Coverage: National/Rural and Urban/All four provinces; Mode: Face to face; Survey dates: May 30 - June 6, 2016. Estimated error margin: ± 3 -5% at 95% confidence level.

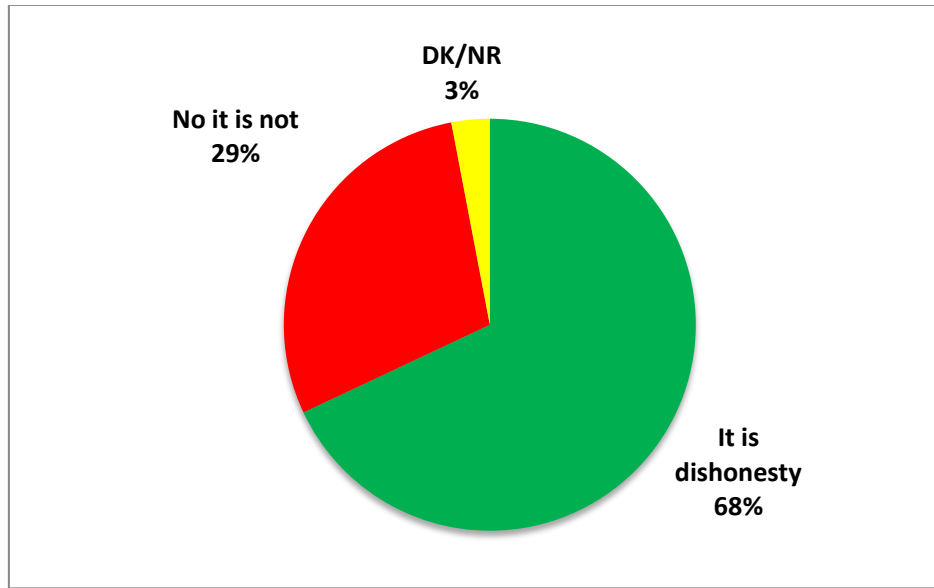

Key Finding # 2:

However, 62% disagree with Imran Khan's demand that the Prime Minister should resign

Question: Certain news item claim that Imran Khan owns off shore companies overseas but as of yet he has not, himself, declared any of these companies. Some people are of the opinion that as Imran Khan himself owns off shore companies, he is no position to demand Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif's resignation as it is dishonesty. Some people hold a different opinion than this, what's your opinion?

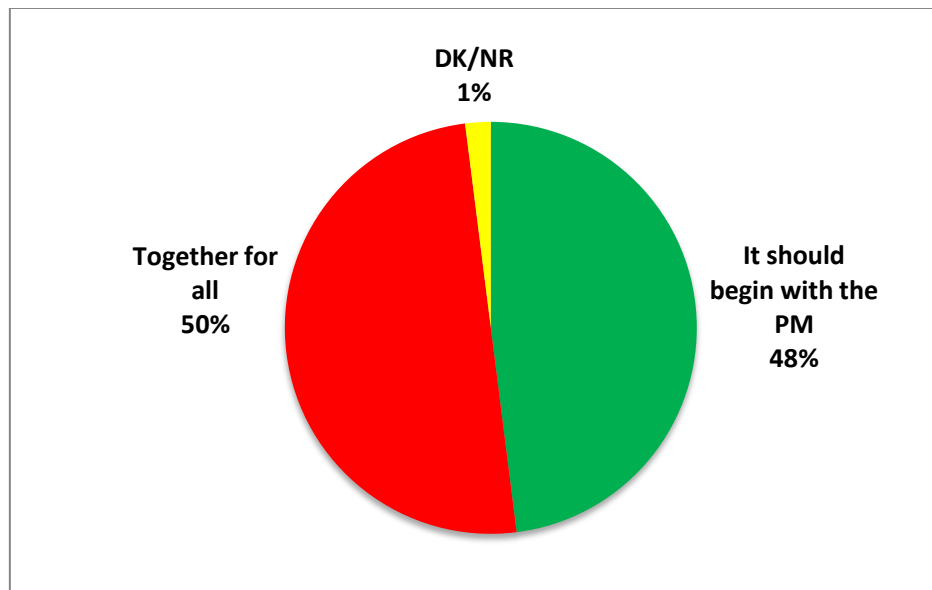

Key Finding # 3:

Nevertheless, views are equally split (48% versus 50%) between those who favour and others who oppose that the Investigations should begin with the Prime Minister

Question: Some people are of the opinion that the investigation on the Panama Leaks should begin with PM Nawaz Shareef while some are of the opinion that the investigation of all those mentioned in the papers should be done together. What is your opinion regarding this?
