Concerns Regarding Internet; The Greatest Concern Turns out to be 'Fraud': GILANI POLL /GALLUP PAKISTAN

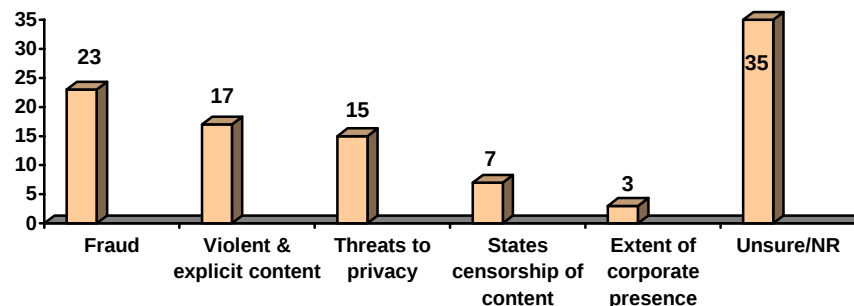

According to a Gilani Research Foundation survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the main internet-related concern amongst Pakistanis appears to be fraud as cited by 23% of the respondents. This is followed by other concerns such as violent and explicit content (17%), threats to privacy (15%), state censorship of content (7%), and extent of corporate presence (3%). The remaining 35% were either unaware about internet or gave no response.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the country were asked “Which one of the following aspects of the internet are you most concerned about?” Twenty three percent (23%) said “Fraud” is the biggest problem of internet, 17% cited “Violent and Explicit Content”, 15% cited “Threats to Privacy”, 7% said “State’s Censorship of Content” is the biggest problem, whereas 3% cited “Extent of corporate presence” as their biggest worry regarding internet. The remaining 35% of the respondents were either unaware about internet or gave no response.

The findings of the survey reveal that, a proportionately higher percentage of people over the age of 50 were unaware about internet and could not answer the question.

The study was released by Gilani foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2772 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during January 2010. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
